A By-law to authorize the borrowing of \$ 15,000.00

Whereas the Council of the Township of Georgina (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 15,000.00 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 19 , not including revenues derivable or derived from the sale of assets, borrowings or issues of debentures or from a surplus, including arrears of taxes and proceeds from the sale of assets, is \$ 65,000.00

(Delete this paragraph if not applicable.)

And Whereas the total amount heretofore authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of Section 341 of the Municipal Act is \$ of which the Municipality has already borrowed a total of \$

Therefore the Council of the Township of Georgina hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ 15,000.00 to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of Section 341 of the Municipal Act, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 341, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1952 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF Georgina IN THE COUNTY OF York DISTRICT OF York

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act requires that the total expenditure on roads be provided for annually by by-law and that the by-law be submitted to The Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows:

- (1) The sum of \$ 60,000.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads under its jurisdiction during the year 1952 as follows:-

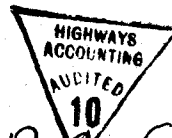

MUNICIPAL BORROWING BY-LAW FOR }
ORDINARY EXPENDITURE—ONTARIO }

BY-LAW No. 220

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the *Township* of *Georgina* to borrow an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of *5000⁰⁰*

dollars to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates purposes and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section 339 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 266, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1937.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of *Five Thousand* dollars until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.
2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and Treasurer and the said Bank.
3. That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law the Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.
4. That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum borrowed under this By-law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.
5. That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required by the said Bank.

BY-LAW NO. 222

A By-Law for prohibiting the obstruction of any drain or watercourse and for permitting and regulating the size and mode of construction of culverts and bridges which cross any drain or watercourse situate on any public highway in the Township of Georgina.

WHEREAS Councils of local municipalities are authorized under Section 388, subsection 83, R. S. O. 1950, Chapter 243 to pass By-laws for the purposes aforesaid.

THE COUNCIL of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina THEREFORE ENACTS as follows:-

- (1) THAT no one shall obstruct any drain or watercourse .
- (2) THAT no one shall construct any culvert or bridge which crosses any drain or watercourse situate on any public highway within the Municipal limits without first obtaining the consent of the Road Superintendant and having the work done under his supervision.
- (3) Every person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law, shall on conviction before a magistrate be subject to fine not exceeding \$50.00 exclusive of costs.
- (4) Every such penalty shall be recoverable under THE SUMMARY CONVICTIONS ACT.

A By-Law to change the Polling Sub-Divisions in the Municipality of the Township of Georgina in the County of York.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:

That Polling Sub/Division No. *One* comprise lots 1 to 12 in Concessions 1, 2, 3 and 4, South half of Lot 5 and 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 in Concession 5.

That Polling Sub-Division No. *Two* comprise lots 13 to 25 in Concessions 1, 2 and 3.

That Polling Sub-Division No. *Three* comprise lots 1 to 6 both lots inclusive in Concessions 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, except south half lot 5 and all lot 6, Concession 5.

That Polling Sub-Division No. *Four* comprise lots 7 to 15 both lots inclusive in concessions 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, lots 16, 17, and 18, Concession 8, and point of land known as Ducllo's Point, except lots 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11, Concession 5.

That Polling Sub-Division No. *Five* comprise lots 13 to 25 both lots inclusive in Concession 4, lots 16 to 25 both lots included in Concession 5.

Polling Sub-Division No. *Six* comprise lots 16 to 25 both lots inclusive in Concessions 6 and 7 and lots 23, 24 and 25 Concession 8.

That all By-Laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
