A By-law to authorize the borrowing of \$ 30,000.00

Whereas the Council of the Township of Georgina (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 30,000.00 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 19 53, not including revenues derivable or derived from the sale of assets, borrowings or issues of debentures or from a surplus, including arrears of taxes and proceeds from the sale of assets, is \$ 75,000.00

(Delete this paragraph if not applicable.)

And Whereas the total amount heretofore authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of Section 341 of The Municipal Act is \$ of which the Municipality has already borrowed a total of \$

R.S.W.

Therefore the Council of the Township of Georgina hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ 30,000.00 to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of Section 341 of the Municipal Act, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding 4 1/2 per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 341, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows:

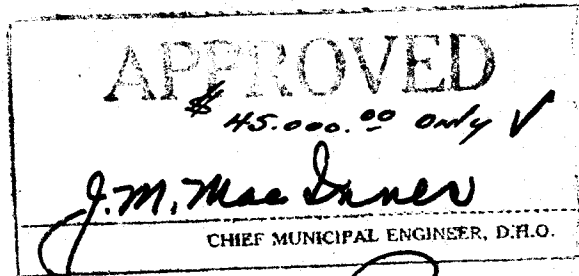

WHEREAS pursuant to R. S. O. Chapter 243, Section 388, Subsection (II2) Townships are authorized to pass By-laws for prohibiting and regulating the ringing of bells, blowing of horns, shouting and unusual noises or noises calculated to disturb the inhabitants.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina deems it expedient to pass a by-law for the aforesaid purposes.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina ENACTS as follows:-

THAT no person shall ring bells, blow horns, shout or make unusual noises or noises calculated to disturb the inhabitants within the limits of the said Corporation.

Any person who contravenes this by-law or any provisions thereof shall be subject on conviction to a fine of Not more than \$50.00 exclusive of costs and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 21 days.

EVERY penalty under this By-law shall be recoverable under THE SUMMARY CONVICTIONS ACT, all of the provisions of which shall apply.

BY-LAW NO. 238

A By-Law to prohibit the passing of vehicles on certain Township roads in the Township of Georgina.

And whereas it is deemed expedient by reason of the winding narrow road and density of population, that ~~the~~ passing of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina be prohibited.

1. No vehicle shall pass another upon the following designated highway in the Township of Georgina, that is the road from the limits of the Village of Sutton easterly to the St. George's Church (easterly limits lot 6) in the 8th Concession, better known as the Hedge road and the Mossington Park area road.
2. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-Law shall be subject on conviction to a fine of not more than \$50.00 exclusive of costs, and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twenty-one days.

WHEREAS Subsection 1 of Section 204 of the Municipal Act provides that a Municipal Council may pass a By-Law to hold the first meeting of the Council prior to the second Monday in January.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:-

THAT the first meeting of the 1954 Council be held on the first Monday of January at the hour of 1:30 p.m.
