First-meeting 1900

Pursuant to Statute Council elect for the year 1900 met at Pefferlaw on Monday January 8th at 11 o'clock A.M. when the following members subscribed to the necessary Declaration of qualification and of Office, Reeve Wesley Jackson, Councillors John Evans, William Moore, Philip Snooks and Richard F. Bronsberry,

Communications were received from J. Ross Robertson re grant to Hospital for Sick Children, Municipal World re subscriptions, J. D. McKay re Township printing, John S. Graham re refund of dog tax, several small accounts were also received

Moved by Mr. Moore seconded by Mr. Bronsberry that the Township printing and advertising for the current year be given to J. D. McKay at last years figure viz \$28.⁰⁰/₁₀₀,-

Second meeting 1900

Pursuant to adjournment Council met
at Udora on Thursday Feb 1st, members all present.
Minutes of former meeting read and confirmed.

The Commissioners appointed to exam-
ine the Bridge over the mouth of the Western Black
River reported that on examination of same
they thought it advisable ^{owing} to the unsafeness
of the old bridge to have a new one built, and
in accordance with instructions from Council
had prepared plan & specifications ~~for same~~,
and had also asked for tenders for building
same, which was laid before the Council
as follows J. H. Glendinning \$250, M. Wmphy
\$237, Thos. Armstrong \$236, Broad & Harvey \$209,
Healon & Corner \$208,

The Auditor's Report & also a few small ac-
counts were also laid before Council,

Moved by Mr. Evans seconded by Mr. Moore
that the tender of Healon & Corner for the erection
of the Bridge over the Western Black River on the
lakeshore road for the sum of \$208, be accepted,
said parties to give a Bond for the due ful-
filment of contract, and that the Reeve and
Clark are hereby appointed to attend to the
execution of said bond,

Third Meeting 1900

Pursuant to adjournment - Council met at Baldwin on Monday May 28th, members all present, minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted,

After subscribing to the necessary oath Council resolved into Court of Revision, the Clerk reported that there were no appeals to Roll, but one or two changes asked for, on motion of Mr. Evans seconded by Mr. Bronsberry the Court adjourned until 3 o'clock in the afternoon,

On resuming Mr. Evans moved seconded by Mr. Bronsberry that the 1/2 & 3/4th of lot 20 Con 3 be assessed to James Kavanagh for the sum of \$100- and that the dog assessed to Richard Bronsberry be struck off the roll and that when these changes have been made that the assessment-Roll for 1900 be finally revised and adopted, and that this Court of Revision do now adjourn sine die,

When general Business was taken up several accounts were presented, also the Auditor's report of township accounts, several parties made application to be allowed to do their labor in divisions other than that in which their property lay, a few changes in the Road divisions were also asked for,

Charles Ringle appeared before the Council in reference to an account for goods supplied to one A. Sedore during quarantine for Diphtheria which was laid over, The Reeve reported that he and the Clerk had met a similar committee from the Township of Scott, and had entered into an agreement that each municipality should for a term of two years expend annually for the maintenance of the townline the sum of \$45, every day's statutory labor performed thereon to be valued at fifty-cents, and that later on he would introduce a By-law embodying said agreement,

Moved by Mr. Snooks seconded by Mr. Evans that the Auditor's report of township accounts together with abstract of same and statement of assets and liabilities as presented to this Council be adopted and that the Clerk get 100 copies printed in pamphlet form for distribution,

Moved by Mr. Evans seconded by Mr. Moore that the name of Robert Riddell as overseer of Road division No 11 be erased from By-law No 2, 1900, and that the name of Alfred Shaw be substituted therefor,

Moved by Mr. Evans seconded by Mr. Bronsby that a new road division be formed out of division No 24, to be known as No 40, said division to commence on the 4th ^{run} con line between lots 9 & 10 con 3, and eastward to the sideline between 18 & 19, with the labor adjacent thereto, and

and that Bartlett Sherwood be and is hereby appointed overseer thereof, and that that portion of roadway from Moores Corner to the Peppulaw Bridge, which last year was annexed to road division No 17, be transferred back to No 16, -
