Pursuant to adjournment and notice Council met at Pefferlaw on Saturday May 27. at 10 o'clock a.m.

The clerk reported that he had been unable to get a settlement with North Guillemburg township or townline expenditures, but they had agreed to forward a statement of their expenditures early in the New Year.

He also reported that with the ex-

ception of a few items that had been paid to-day, that the townships of Scott & Georgina were even on townline expenditure, and that he had met a representative from Brock township and after taking into consideration all labor performed & cash expended on the townline proper between these municipalities that Georgina was in excess of Brock \$35.86,

He also reported that the township of Brock had expended \$62.90 in building a cement culvert on the pier of angling road along the lake shore just east of Port Bolster, leading from the townline between Brock & Georgina to the townline between Brock & Thorak and had charged Georgina with one half of the cost, but as your Commissioner does not consider this pier of roadway a boundary line he did not allow this portion of their charge,

By-law No 109 appointing a place and hour for holding nomination also polling places Deputy Returning Officer & poll books was then introduced & passed, also By-law No 110, making provisions for the payment of certain township officer was also put through its various stages & passed, after which on motion of Mr Shier seconded by Mr Stiles Council adjourned sine die,
