

Minutes of the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina

First Meeting 1912

Pursuant to Statute Council Elect for the year 1912 viz. Richard Bronsbery Reeve, Charles Stiles, Harry Duncan, Allan Snoddon and William Lake Councillors met on Monday January 8<sup>th</sup> at 11 o'clock a. m. at Pefferlaw, and after subscribing to the necessary Declaration of qualification and of office took their seats at the Council Board.

Communications were received from Wm. H. Ego & Frank Harvey applying for the office of Assessor for 1912, the former offering to do same for \$55.00 including extras and the latter for \$55.00.

The Resignation of Mr George Evans who has been Treasurer for thirty five years was received and read, also an application from Wm. C. Evans applying for the office.

A Representative from the Canadian Northern D. Railway waited on Council and asked that said Company be given until the Spring of 1912 to construct crossing where their road crosses the 8<sup>th</sup> Con line at Port Bolster, He also asked for permission for said Railway Co to remove the gravel on the 4<sup>th</sup> Con line opposite where their gravel pit was the Company to pay for said privilege and to keep a road open for travel while they were removing same, and to leave road.

Third Meeting 1912

Pursuant to adjournment Council met at Pefferlaw on Saturday March 30<sup>th</sup> at two o'clock in the afternoon,

Members all present, minutes of former meeting were read and adopted.

A Communication was received and read from A. Brogie re accident to Enoch Brown.

Several plans & estimates for a steel bridge over the river at Pefferlaw was laid before Council.

The Board of Trustees of S.S. No 2 applied to Council to pass a By-law to issue Debentures for a loan of \$4500, to build a new School House in said section, said loan to extend over a period of twenty years and to bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum.

A. J. Reid representing the C. N. O. Railway waited on Council and arranged basis of agreement between the Township and the Railway to the removal of gravel from off the 4<sup>th</sup> Con line opposite lot 14.

A Representative from the Toronto Safe Works waited on Council and advocated that the Council purchase a safe to keep all their valuable papers books &c.

A number of accounts were also received & dealt with.

W. J. Button representing the Ontario Bridge Co was also present and explained the merits of the steel bridge as built by their company.

Fourth Meeting 1912
