First Meeting 1912

Third Meeting 1912

Pursuant to adjournment Council met at Pefferlaw on Saturday March 30 at two o'clock in the afternoon.

Members all present Minutes of former meeting were read and adopted.

A communication was received and read from A. Beogin re accident to Enoch Brown.

Several plans & estimates for a Steel Bridge over the river at Pefferlaw was laid before Council.

The Board of Trustees of S.S. No 2 applied to Council to pass a By-law to issue Debenture for a loan of \$4500, to build a new School House in said section, said loan to extend over a period of twenty years and to bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum.

A. J. Reid representing the G. T. O. Railway waited on Council and arranged basis of agreement between the Township and the Railway Co. for the removal of gravel from off the 4th Con line opposite lot 14.

A Representative from the Toronto Safe Works waited on Council and advocated that the Council purchase a safe to keep all their valuable papers books etc.

W. J. Button representing the Ontario Bridge Co. was also present and explained the merits of the steel bridge as built by their company.
