First Meeting 1915

Pursuant to Statute Council elect for 1915 viz: Richard Bronsberry Reeve Charles W. Stiles, William Henry Taylor John L. Cockburn & Allan Snoddon Councillors met on Monday January 11th at 11 o'clock A.M. at the Hall Keffelaw.

And after subscribing to the necessary declarations of qualifications and of office to their seats at the Council Board.

The following communications were received from Sick Children's Hospital or donation from Municipal world or subscription, from Wilmet Riddell & Mrs H. Ego asking for the appointment to the office of Assessor. Also several accounts.

Mr Charles Pringle appeared before Council and stated that Mrs Morton an indigent was ill and asked that some arrangements be made so that she would be properly looked after & stated that Mrs Gills of Baldwin would do so if she had some guarantee that she would be paid for so doing. The Council informed Mr Pringle that they would pay Mrs Gills \$1.00 per day, which he stated would be quite satisfactory.

By-Law No 141 was introduced apointing Jno W. Westgarth & Charles Anderson Auditor, Wilmet Riddell Assessor, Jno S. Kay Collector of Taxes, Dr Boynton the Reeve and Clerk Members of the Board of Health, said By-Law was read a first, second and third time & the Reeve ordered to sign same and attach corporate seal thereto.
