First Meeting 1918

Fourth Meeting 1918

Pursuant to adjournment and notice Council met at Peffulaw on Tuesday May 28<sup>th</sup> at 10-30 a.m.

Members all present, minutes of previous meeting read and adopted. After subscribing to the necessary oath Council resolved into a Court of Revision and proceeded to revise the Assessment Roll for 1918.

There were no appeals lodged against the assessments but several changes asked for and a number of requests to have dogs struck off Roll, after taking all application into consideration it was moved by Mr. Snaddon seconded by Mr. Taylor that C. H. Elliott of Toronto be assessed for lot & plan 118 instead of W. J. Myers.

That Mrs. Jacob Woodwick be assessed for Mirah Rogers House & lot in Peffulaw, that Thomas Skinner be placed on roll as tenant for the Frank Harvey lots & Jenn Ellison tenant for Thos Skinner lot, and Charles Rutter tenant for J. W. Rutter's lot in Uelora.

That one dog each be struck off the assessments of George Arnold, E. G. Coome, Dicus Sudor, and one bitch of that of Geo. F. Kay, and that when these alterations have been made that the Assessment Roll for 1918 be finally revised and adopted and that the Court of Revision adjourn sine die.

Mr George Corner paid Council Two Dollars for some unused tile on 5<sup>th</sup> Con line.

Henry Rennie asked for refund of Dog Tax his dog having disappeared about first of June.
