

Minutes of the Municipal Council  
of the Township of Georgina

First Meeting 1922

Pursuant to Statute Council Elect for the year 1922 Viz. Richard Lonsbury, Rev. Guy Burgess, Leslie Lockburn, Donald McDonald and Artemus J. Lee Councillors met on Monday January 9<sup>th</sup> at 11 o'clock A. M. and after subscribing to the necessary declaration of office took their seats at the Council board.

A number of accounts communication & were received & laid before Council, from Sick Children's Hospital or grant from Municipal World or subscriptions & Dog tags from Vance & Co on Dog tags, from W. Kiddell on appointment as Assessor.

The Collector Roll was also laid before Council the collector for 1921 having completed the collection of taxes.

Messrs J. H. Bodley & John S. Moore addressed Council in reference to making a grant towards the School Fair.

Moved by Mr Lee seconded by Mr Lockburn - That the Collector Roll for 1921 be accepted as presented, said Roll showing \$4.00 for a bitch that cannot be collected, and the sum of \$288.89 for real estate of Non-Residents and that this latter amount be returned to the County Treasurer as the law directs;

Fourth Meeting 1922

Pursuant to adjournment and advertisement Council met at Pefferlaw on Monday May 29 at 1-30 P. M.

Members all present; Minutes of former meeting read and adopted. After subscribing to the necessary oath Council resolved into a Court of Revision to revise the Assessment Roll for 1922.

The following appeals were laid before the Court. W. A. Blasdale, Hubert Carveth, Dr. A. Sanderson, John Andrus and Charles Dudge.

Mr Blasdale & Charles Dudge each appeared before the Court in reference to their appeals.

Several changes were asked for in reference to assessments.

After hearing all parties and after comparing assessments it was moved by Mr Burgess seconded by Mr Lockburn that the assessment of W. A. Blasdale and that of Hubert Carveth each be reduced \$300.-.
