First meeting 1923

Pursuant to Statute Council met at Pefferlaw on Monday January 8 at 11 o'clock A. M. when the following members subscribed to the necessary declaration of officer and took their seats at the Council board, namely Richard Barnsberry Reeve, George Burgess Donald McDonald & Artimus Lee Councillors Leslie Cockburn being absent.

The Clerk then read the minutes of the last meeting of 1922 which was adopted.
