Carried.

The matter of the offer of \$2000.00 by the Executor John Johnston of the late Mrs. Hobbs' Estate and the offer of the present Hall and property at Piffelaw by the Trustee J. S. Moore to the Municipal Council. to erect a hall with seating capacity equal to size of present Hall, and to own same was discussed.
