

# Minutes of the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina.

First meeting 1929.

Pursuant to statute the following members of Georgina Township Council met at Pefferlaw on Monday January 14<sup>th</sup> 1929 at 11.30 a.m.

Reeve, Wilmot Riddell, Councillors, R. H. Corner, J. A. Latimer, Moberly Matt, and Arthur Baker.

After subscribing to the necessary declaration of Office, they took their seats at the Council Board for the year 1929.

The minutes of the last meeting of 1928 were read and confirmed.

The Collector's Roll was presented and it was moved by Councillor Corner seconded by Councillor Matt that the Collector be responsible for the collection of \$4.00 dog tax and \$178.64 for resident tax, but be relieved of \$2.00 dog tax that cannot be collected and \$392.00 of unpaid taxes for real estate of non-residents the latter amount to be returned to the County Treasurer as the law directs. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Baker seconded by Councillor Matt that the Collector of Taxes be instructed to collect \$2.00 dog tax from Robert Hunt or have dog destroyed according to law, also dog tax to be collected from M. E. Hamilton as the Assessor tendered him an assessment notice and the dog was assessed on said notice. That the dog tax of Harlow Jewell be struck off the Roll as he has moved from the County and we have no power to collect. Carried.

A communication from D. L. W. Dales of Newmarket requesting financial assistance to erect a sign to divert traffic Easterly and Westerly from Yonge St. It was moved by Councillor Latimer seconded by Councillor Baker that the Clerk be instructed to write Dr. Dales referring him to the Sutton Board of Trade which has a representative from this Township. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Corner seconded by Councillor Matt that an error in adjusting Townline account with Scott Township to the amount of \$5.00 be paid. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Baker seconded by Councillor Corner that the Reeve and Councillor Matt be appointed to the management Board of the Community Hall Pifferslaw for the year 1929. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Corner seconded by Councillor Matt that the Clerk be instructed to order seven copies of the Municipal World for one year. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Baker seconded by Councillor Matt that the Reeve and Clerk be hereby authorized to sign a By-Law to collect the grant on Road expenditures from the Department of Public Works and Highways of the Province of Ontario provided for by the Ontario Highways Act. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Latimer seconded by Councillor Baker that a detailed itemized statement of Township accounts for 1928 be prepared and printed for distribution said statement to contain auditors certificate. Carried.

### Fifth Meeting 1929.

The Council of the Township of Georgina met at Pefferlaw on Monday May 27<sup>th</sup> 1929. at 11.15 a m. for the purpose of holding Court of Revision and general business. Members all present.

The Council then signed the necessary oaths as members of the Court of Revision. They then proceeded to deal with the revising of the assessment Roll.

Carried.

A Delegation from the Lake Shore Road. waited on the Council re closing of the Road from the Black River Bridge to road no 11 and building a new road in lieu of said road south of the present road approximately in line with the present Hydro line. Moved by Councillor Salinas seconded by Councillor Baker that this Council is in accord with said proposition presented by J. E. Sibbald on behalf of the property owners adjacent to said road, and that we meet Mr Sibbald and said owners on the ground to further investigate and discuss said proposition, and that Messrs. R. F. Crowley, Geo. Johnston, Chas. Pungle, Jas. Perry and H. J. Norman be a committee of representatives ratepayers to convene with said Council and owners on June 5<sup>th</sup> at one o'clock P.M. Carried.

### Special Meeting

The Council of the Township of Georgina met at Pefferlaw on Monday the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September 1929 at 2.30 P.M. for the purpose of dealing with the objections against the closing of the Lake Shore Road from the Black River Bridge east to the Stone Church.

Members all present except Councillor Baker.

The Reeve opened the meeting by outlining the proposition that was brought before the Council in regard to the closing of the Road.

Mr Osborne, Reeve of the Village of Sutton addressed the Council asking that the resolution passed by the Council of the Village of Sutton be accepted as their objection toward the closing of said Road.

Dr. C. F. Noble spoke against the closing of the Road on account of the Tourist Traffic.

Dr. A. J. Lake spoke against the closing of the Road as a detriment to his property and the Township as a whole.

Other objectors toward the closing of the Road were Edm. Br. Sibbald, James Anderson, Walker Gillispie and Adelaide Brews.

Messrs. J. D. Sibbald and W. D. Oliver addressed the meeting in favor of diverting the Road as a safeguard to the public and a financial benefit to the Township.

After hearing the objections, it was moved by Councillor Latimer seconded by Councillor Matt. whereas several objections have been registered opposing the passing of the By-law re changing or diverting the Lake Shore Road from the Black River Bridge east to Sibbalds Church and whereas there is a great diversity of opinion prevailing as to the actual jurisdiction of this Township on said road as to width
