First Meeting 1930.

Simcoe are underweight. Carried.

Taylor that D. M. Riddell be refunded \$1.38 taxes  
it being an error in his assessment. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Taylor seconded by Councillor  
Latimer that the Clerk be instructed to order seven  
copies of the Municipal World for one year. Carried.

Taylor that we pay the Village of Sutton as per

Moved by Councillor Taylor seconded by Councillor Latimer that Allen Snodden be and is hereby appointed School Attendance Officer for the Township of Georgina and that the Clerk be instructed to prepare a By-Law to be passed at the next meeting. Carried.

Second Meeting 1930

The Council of the Township of Georgina met at Pefferlaw on Monday February 24<sup>th</sup> 1930 at three P.M.

Members all present, minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Communications were than read.

The Collector Roll was presented but as it showed several accounts uncollected and no statement as to what amount of the five per cent had been paid to the Treasurer it was moved by Councillor Baker seconded by Councillor Taylor that we extend the Collector time for returning the Roll to the March meeting, and that the Collector be instructed to make a report to the Council of the total amount the five per cent had brought to the Township Treasurer. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Taylor seconded by Councillor Corner that the Clerk be instructed to write W. A. Ego. Bailiff. asking him to pay to the Treasurer of the Township of Georgina the five per cent on taxes he collected. Carried.

A number of trees having been cut down along the Pefferlaw road it was moved by Councillor Satimer seconded by Councillor Corner that the Clerk be instructed to ascertain who was responsible for the cutting of the trees, also to get an estimate of the damages. Carried.

Mr J. Semple waited on the Council re selling of trees on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Cor opposite Mrs Guthrie's property it was moved by Councillor Taylor seconded by Councillor Corner that Councillor Baker be instructed to sell those trees. Carried.

The Auditor's report was presented and it was moved by Councillor Satimer seconded by Councillor Taylor that the Council accept the report as

presented, and that the Clerk be instructed to have the usual number of copies printed  
Carried.

Moved by Councillor Taylor seconded by Councillor Baker that the Road Superintendent be instructed to sell by auction the old timber from the bridge on the fifth Con.  
Carried.

Moved by Councillor Taylor seconded by Councillor Latimer that the Road Superintendent be instructed to attend the Good Roads Convention.  
Carried.

Moved by Councillor Latimer seconded by Councillor Corner that R. Cronsberry and W. H. Taylor be hereby appointed Vice Inspectors for the Township of Georgina for the year 1930.  
Carried.

Moved by Councillor Latimer seconded by Councillor Corner that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Public Highways of the Province of Ontario the petitions of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina, showing that during the period Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> 1929 to Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> 1929 there has been expended upon the Township Roads the sum of \$6565.<sup>76</sup> and requesting the statutory grant on that amount as provided by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto.
