Moved by Councillor Harvey seconded by Councillor Cockburn that the Clerk be instructed to prepare a By-Law giving the Assessor power to collect the dog tax at the time he delivers the dog tags, the By-Law to be passed at the next meeting of the Council. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Tomlinson seconded by Councillor Cockburn that the names of R. H. Corner and J. D. Sibbald be appointed to the Management Board of the Community Hall at Pefferlaw for the year 1938 for the Council. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Cockburn seconded by Councillor Harvey that Richard Crossberry be and is hereby appointed Weed Inspector for the Township of Georgina for the year 1938. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Cockburn seconded by Councillor Harvey that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Public Highways of the Province of Ontario, the petition of the Corporation of

of the Township of Georgina showing that during the year January 1st 1937 to December 31st 1937 there has been expended on the Township Roads \$7098.⁵² and requesting the Statutory grant on that amount as provided by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto. Carried.

Be it resolved that this municipality strongly protests against this action, whereas during the year 1937 the ice on the Lake was not safe for the fisherman to go out for trout consequently there was fewer licenses

sold. as this means a living for a good many of the Residents of this Municipality during the Winter months when there is no employment and keeps them off relief, we would urgently request you to have the Resident License restored as in former years, and the Clerk be instructed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Department of game and fisheries. Carried.

Special Meeting 1938

A special meeting of the Council of the Township of Georgina, on Monday the 18th day of July at 8. P.M.

The meeting being called by the Reeve, for the purposes of passing a By-law in regard to speed on the Highways and other important business, members all present.

Moved by Councillor Tomlinson seconded by Councillor Lockburn. whereas The Road known as the Hedge Road in the Township of Georgina along the shore of Lake Simcoe, from Jackson's Point to St George's Church, is narrow with several curves, and as there is a heavy traffic on this road which is very dangerous to the Residents and Summer Residents who live on this Highway, especially the children. Also the Road known as the Pefferlaw Road starting at the School House in the Village of Pefferlaw to a cement bridge known as the Corner Bridge, this is curved with many residents with children living on it, also a heavy traffic passes over this road. Be it resolved that a By-law restricting the speed limit to thirty miles an hour be passed and forwarded to the Department of Highways for their approval. Carried.
