

First meeting 1939.

The inaugural meeting of the Township of Georgina Council was held on Monday the 9th day of January 1939 at 11 a.m.

Reeve, L. J. Cockburn, Councillors: J. D. Sibbald, Ivan Tomlinson, Herb Cronsberry and John Saviolette after subscribing to the necessary declaration of office, took their seats on the Council Board for the year 1939.

R. H. Corner retiring Reeve and Warden of York County addressed the Council, ^{with some} well chosen remarks.

Communications were read and dealt with.

Moved by Councillor Saviolette seconded by Councillor Tomlinson that the Township of Georgina agrees to a reciprocal arrangement with the City of Toronto and the other municipalities in the County of York whereby the summonses are served by each municipalities Police force without charge. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Sibbald seconded by Councillor Tomlinson that the Clerk be instructed to order eight copies of the Municipal World for one year.

Carried.

Moved by Councillor Saviolette seconded by Councillor Cronsberry that the tender of the Reporter Printing Company as outlined in their tender of January 4th for the printing and advertising for 1939 for the sum of \$148.⁰⁰ be accepted. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Sibbald seconded by Councillor Tomlinson that a grant of \$50.⁰⁰ be allowed the Trustees for the Township Hall, Pefferlaw. The grant being \$25.⁰⁰ larger than for 1938 to help cover the deficit between current revenues and expenditures. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Sibbald seconded by Councillor Cronsberry that the Collector's time for returning the Roll be extended until the next

regular meeting of the Council. Carried

Moved by Councillor Tomlinson seconded by Councillor Saviolette that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Public Highways of the Province of Ontario, the petition of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina showing that during the year January 1st 1938 to December 31st 1938 there has been expended on the Township Roads \$11467.⁸⁷ and requesting the Statutory grant on that amount as provided by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto. winter fishing of Lake trout on Lake Simcoe, we hereby respectfully request the Government to continue the practise of allowing the spearing of Lake trout through the ice on Lake Simcoe and the sale of such Lake Simcoe trout so taken as.

1 This industry is the only means open to many of our people to enable them to provide for their families during the winter months.

2 To withdraw the issuing of spear licenses for lake trout on Lake Simcoe would increase the direct relief costs of the Municipality and consequently to the Province as well, to many times the amount formerly expended annually by the Municipality for direct relief.

3 We understand that the Possibility of cancelling spear licenses for lake trout would be with the idea of increasing the possibility of taking lake trout by angling and we must stress the fact that in the Tourist season of July and August lake trout have already left the shore waters and in that period are to be found only in the deep water some four or five miles from shore. For this reason we know that the taking of lake trout by angling during the tourist season would not be facilitated or increased by the cancelling of winter fishing privileges.
