

### First meeting 1941

The inaugural meeting of the Township of Georgina Council held Monday the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1941, Council met at 10.45 A.M.

Reeve, L. J. Cockburn, Councillors, C. F. Anderson, Herbert Cronsberry, G. H. Graham and J. C. Taylor.

After subscribing to the necessary declaration of Office took their seats on the Council Board for the year 1941.

In a few brief remarks the Reeve welcomed the new members to the Council and made some comments on the work for the year stating that economy should be the main object of every member of the Council.
