

First Meeting 1942

The inaugural meeting of the Township of Georgina Council held on Monday the 12th day of January 1942. Council met at 11.15 a.m.

Reeve J. D. Sibbald, Councillors, P. H. Corner, Herb. Crosberry, G. H. Graham and Wilfred Riddell.

After subscribing to the necessary declaration of office took their seats on the Council Board for the year 1942.

In a few brief remarks Councillor Corner stressed co-operation ~~among~~^{with} the Council and with the Municipal Officer, after which the Reeve addressed the new Council making comments on the work for the year and stating that economy was one of the main issues, also asked for full co-operation from the members of the Council and the Officer of the Municipality.

Moved by Councillor Crosberry seconded by Councillor Riddell that the Collector's time for returning the Roll be extended until the next regular meeting of the Council Carried.

Moved by Councillor Corner seconded by Councillor Riddell that J. D. Sibbald and G. H. Graham be hereby appointed to the Community Hall Board to represent the Council for the year 1942 according to the Community Halls Act. Carried

Moved by Councillor Riddell seconded by Councillor Crosberry that the Clerk be instructed to order eight copies of the Municipal World for one year Carried.

Moved by Councillor Graham seconded by Councillor Crosberry that the Clerk and Reeve be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Public Highways of the Province of Ontario, the petition of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina showing that during the year January 1st 1941 to December 31st 1941 there has been expended on the Township Roads

a total of \$5089.54 and requesting the statutory grant on that amount as provided by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto. Carried
