

First Meeting 1943.

The inaugural meeting of the Township of Georgina Council held on Monday the 11th day of January 1943, Council met at 1.30 P.M.

Reeve, J. D. Sibbald, Councillors, R. H. Corner, Herb. Cronsberry, G. H. Graham and Wilfrid Riddell.

After subscribing to the necessary declaration of Office took their seats on the Council Board for the year 1943.

The minutes of the last meeting of the 1942 Council were read and adopted.

Moved by Councillor Cronsberry seconded by Councillor Riddell that whereas owing to the meat shortage for human consumption, rationing of the same is under consideration by our Government.

And that whereas Lake Simcoe contains an abundance of fish, now therefore be it resolved that the Department of Game and Fisheries be requested to permit the taking of fish by spear from Lake Simcoe in order to ease the meat shortage in this district, and that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Department of Game and Fisheries asking that they will grant this request. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Corner seconded by Councillor Riddell that the Collectors time for returning the Roll be extended until the next regular meeting of the Council. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Cronsberry seconded by Councillor Graham that the Clerk be instructed to order nine copies of the Municipal World for one year. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Corner seconded by Councillor Cronsberry that the Clerk and Reeve be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Public Highways of the Province of Ontario, the petition of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina showing that during the year January 1st 1942 to December

31st 1942 there has been expended on the Township Roads a total of \$5544.²¹ and requesting the statutory grant on that amount as provided by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto. Carried
