### Special Meeting

A special meeting of the Council of the Township of Georgina called by the Reeve, to consider the attitude of the City of Toronto towards the Toronto and York Roads Commission, held at Pefferlaw on Friday the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1944 at 2. P. M.

Members all present except Councillor Foster.

Moved by Councillor Graham seconded by Councillor Crossberry that this Council of the Municipality of the Township of Georgina go on record as opposing the application of the City of Toronto to the provincial Government to be released from their agreement to pay 25% of the Toronto and York suburban roads system. This arrangement was entered into in good faith by the County of York representing its constituent municipalities. Much of the road construction in the southern part of the County has been completed with the financial assistance of the northern municipalities.

The roads close to the City of Toronto in the County of having been completed the City now wish to be relieved of their contract.

A very large percentage of the motor traffic using the suburban roads originate in the City of Toronto, many business firms in Toronto send trucks out over the suburban roads some of them using fleets of trucks, to the detriment of local businesses.

A great percentage of private motors and 95% of the summer business going to Lake Simcoe, Canada's largest summer resort, originates in Toronto; many of the suburban roads have been built and planned because of this traffic.

Therefore be it resolved as the Cities application is unfair, and inequitable, this Municipality is unalterably opposed to the City of Toronto being relieved of their 25% contribution towards the suburban roads of the Toronto and York good roads system, and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Minister.



A special meeting of the Council of the Township of Georgina called by the Reeve for the purpose of discussing means of snow plowing the Township Roads.

Members all present.

Councillors, Graham, Riddell and Foster along with the Road Superintendent made a



Trip to Toronto on Sept 5<sup>th</sup> to investigate trucks for snow plowing purposes, various firms were called on including G.M.C., International, Mack's. and Fargo.

International truck 6 ton chassis, only, \$6690 with \$650 for dump box with hydraulic hoist.

For to rent of Truck for snow plowing, they asked \$6.00 per day stand by and \$5.00 per hour when in use.

The road Superintendent was instructed to get in touch with the provincial Engineer to find out if they would pay half the cost of a truck.
