

First meeting 1950

The inaugural meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina, held in the Community Hall, Pufferlaw, on Monday the 9th day of January 1950 at 1.30 P.M.

The members having subscribed to the Oath of Declaration of Office took their seats as follows. Reeve, Ralph E. Corner, Deputy Reeve Stuart Taylor, Councillors, Clarence Blanchard, William Mason and Ernest Rixon

The minutes of the last meeting of the 1949 Council was then read.

The Reeve then addressed the new Council with a few well chosen remarks as to some of the more important decisions that will be coming before the Council during 1950.

Moved by Councillor Mason seconded by Councillor Rixon that the Collector's time for returning the 1949 Collector's Roll be extended until the next regular meeting of the Council. Carried

Moved by Councillor Rixon seconded by Councillor Mason that F. R. Dickinson, 51 Rosedale Ave, Toronto be refunded \$28.²¹ taxes plus 28 cents penalty on lot 9 plan 148 concession 8, Georgina Township. This property being also assessed to Henry W. Bleasdale and the taxes paid. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Rixon seconded by Councillor Blanchard that the Collector of taxes be relieved of the collecting of taxes from the County of York to the amount of \$9.⁵⁴ this being the amount levied on this property for secondary education and high school purposes. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Blanchard seconded by Councillor Rixon that the Clerk write a letter of appreciation to the Pufferlaw Women's Institute for having decorated our Municipal Hall with new drapes, and the Women's Institute forward us the names of two of their members that we could appoint as members of the Hall Board for the ensuing two years. Carried

Moved by Councillor Blanchard seconded by Councillor Mason that the Reeve, Deputy Reeve and Councillor Rixon be a committee to engage an auditor for the year 1950. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Rixon seconded by Councillor Mason that the Council meetings for 1950 be held on the first Monday of

each of the following months, February, March, April, November and December at 1. P.M., and the remainder of the months at 8. P.M except the statutory meetings.

Carried.

Moved by Councillor Rixon seconded by Councillor Blanchard that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Public Highways of the Province of Ontario, the petition of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina, showing that during the year January 1st 1949 to December 31st 1949 there has been expended on the Township roads a total of \$39,669.¹⁴ and requesting the statutory grant on that amount as provided for by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto.
