

## First Meeting 1951

The inaugural meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina, held in the Community Hall, Pefferlaw, on Monday the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1951 at 4.30 P.M.

The members of the Council having subscribed to the oath of delation of Office took their seats as follows, Reeve, Ralph E. Corner, Deputy Reeve Stuart Taylor, Councillors, Clarence Blanchard, William Mason and Ernest Pison

The minutes of the last meeting of the 1950 Council was then read and adopted.

The Reeve then addressed the Council with a few well chosen remarks as to some of the important affairs that will be coming before the Council this year

The Collector of taxes presented the 1950 Collector's roll it was moved by Councillor Blanchard seconded by Councillor Mason that it be accepted, the said Roll showing taxes collected \$52,145.<sup>73</sup> penalty collected \$42.<sup>84</sup> and the uncollected taxes \$9,863.<sup>24</sup> Carried.

A proposed plan of part lot 21 Con. 6 submitted by Mr Les Corner moved by Councillor Wm. Mason seconded by Councillor Pison that this Council approve of the proposed plan of the sub-division of part of lot 21 Con 6, restricted to the provisions of the Municipalities Building By Law, that not more than one dwelling be erected on any one lot, that the Municipality of the Township of Georgina will not assume any responsibility for the construction or maintenance of roads within said plan or be liable for any accident or damages that might occur on said plan or be liable for any accident or damages that might occur on said roads, and that the Clerk be instructed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Department of Planning and Development. Carried.
