

First Meeting 1952

The inaugural meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina, held at the Municipal Hall Kefflerlaw, on Monday the 14th day of January 1952 at 1.30 P.M.

The members of the 1952 Council having subscribed to the Oath of declaration of office took their seats as follows. Reeve. Ralph E. Corner, Deputy Reeve Stuart Taylor, Councillors Howard Anderson, J. A. Foster and Wm. Mason.

The Reeve then addressed the Council with a few well chosen remarks and asked for the minutes of the last regular meeting of the 1951 Council.

On taking up general business the Collector of taxes presented the 1951 tax Roll moved by Councillor Foster seconded by Councillor Mason that the Roll be accepted said Roll showing taxes collected \$57,843.03 penalty collected \$35.62 and uncollected taxes \$12,033.83 as at December 31st. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Anderson seconded by Councillor Mason that the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina approve of the proposed plan of the sub-division of part lot 18 Concession VIII owned by A. C. Lock in trust, restricted to the provisions of By-Law no 205 of the Township of Georgina. That the said Municipality will not assume any responsibility for the construction or maintenance of roads within said plan or be liable for any accidents or damages that might occur on said roads, and that the Clerk be instructed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Department of Planning and Development. Carried.

Moved by Deputy Reeve Taylor seconded by Councillor Foster that the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina approve of the proposed plan of the sub-division of part of lot 4 Concession VIII owned by D. Christian, restricted to the provisions of By-Law no 205 of the Township of Georgina, and providing that all arrears of taxes are paid. That the said Municipality will not assume any responsibility for the construction or maintenance of roads within said plan or be liable for any accident or damages that might occur on said roads, and that the Clerk be instructed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Department of Planning and Development. Carried

Moved by Deputy Reeve Taylor seconded by Councillor Anderson that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Highways of the Province of Ontario, the petition of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina, showing that during the year January 1st 1951 to December 31st 1951 there has been expended on the Township roads a total of \$34,342.⁷³. ~~there has been expended on the township roads a total~~ and requesting the statutory grant on that amount as provided for by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto.
