

### First meeting 1953

The inaugural meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina, held at the Township Hall, Pefferlaw, on Monday the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January at 1.30 P.M.

The members of the 1953 council having subscribed to the Oath of Declaration of Office took their places on the Council as follows: Reeve, Ralph E. Corner, Deputy Reeve, Clarence Blanchard, Councillor, J. Howard Anderson, Ellis Pringle and Ernest Rixon

The Reeve then addressed the Council with an outline of some of the problems that will be coming before the Council during the year, and asked for the minutes of the last regular meeting of the 1952 Council to be read.

On taking up general business the Collector of taxes presented the 1952 tax roll moved by Councillor Anderson seconded by Deputy Reeve Blanchard that the 1952 Collector Roll be accepted as presented said Roll showing, taxes collected \$68,503.14, penalty collected \$45.78, taxes written off, \$316.35 and uncollected taxes \$12,766.<sup>50</sup> as at December 31, 1952. Carried

Moved by Councillor Anderson seconded by Councillor Rixon that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and submit to the Minister of Highways of the Province of Ontario, the petition of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina, showing that during the year January 1<sup>st</sup> 1952 to December 31<sup>st</sup> 1952 there has been expended on the Township roads a total of \$45,321.<sup>11</sup> and requesting the statutory grant on that amount as provided for by the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto. Carried.

Moved by Councillor Anderson seconded by Councillor Pringle that the Clerk be authorized to order nine copies of the Municipal World for one year. Carried

Moved by Deputy Reeve Blanchard seconded by Councillor Rixon that a grant of \$200.<sup>00</sup> be made to the Township Hall Board to take care of their responsibilities at this time. Carried.
