Bethaven May 28th 1906

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The Council met as Court of Revision on above date
Members all present Mr. Barker, Chairman, after subscribing to the necessary
Oaths. The appeals were taken up.
Mr. J. H. Brumton and Col. Lloyd attended on behalf
of the Orchard-Beach residents, Mr. Brumton addressed
the Court at some length and explained by the
Assessment Roll that the buildings in that locality
were assessed according to their cost, far higher
than the rest of the Township, he also asked that
greater restrictions be placed on animals running
at large in that vicinity and that the State labor
be not done until after Sept. the first.

Mr. Lillett moved second by Mr. Crowder
that the Assessment Roll as returned by the
Assessor be sustained, and that the Roll
do now pass as finally revised.

The Council then adjourned the Court of Revision
and took up General business. Minutes of previous
meeting read and confirmed. A petition was
presented asking that the Lake Shore road
be not fenced in, thereby shutting residents out
of the Lake front; also a communication
from J. B. Edgar, regarding a fence road
across his property, and suggesting that a road
be opened up from his property to Roachs Point.

that Mary. L. Boye be notified to remove her
fences of the road allowance along Lake-shore
road forthwith. Carried

The council met pursuant to Statute on above date. members all present. minutes of previous meeting read and confirmed.

Mr Lillitt moved second by Mr Crowder that whereas by Bylaw passed on the eighth day of September A.D. 1873, the lands therein described were established as a Public highway; and whereas by Bylaw duly passed on the sixth day of June A.D. 1878. The said highway was closed and stopped up and ceased to be a public highway; and the Reeve of said Township was thereby authorized and empowered, to sell and convey the lands to the best advantage, and by search at the Registry Office for the North Riding of York no further conveyance of said property has been made, and present owner desires the said lands be conveyed to him to perfect his title to said lands; we hereby authorize the Reeve and clerk to sign a proper conveyance of the same and attach the Corporation seal thereto Carried
