

Belhaven Jan 9. 1939

The inaugural meeting of the Council elected for 1939 was held in the Township Hall Belhaven on Monday Jan 9th 1939. Prayer was offered by Rev Mr Skeldon

Present were. Reeve W. E. Morton. Deputy Reeve Ross Mac Millan. Councillors John Hopkins Harold Glover and John Smith

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and by motion approved.

By Laws were passed appointing certain Township officers namely. Howard W. Loughry, Assessor, ^{and Deputy Assessor} Carson Pollock, Road Commissioner, Carl Morton Constable Fred Peel Clerk and Building Inspector

As required by the Highway Improvement Act a By Law was passed providing for appropriation of monies for the construction and maintenance of roads

By Laws were passed authorizing the borrowing of money to meet the current expenditures of the Municipality

Mr. Mac Millan moved seconded by Mr Hopkins that this Council enrol for membership in the Ontario Municipal Association and that the Treasurer be instructed to pay the membership fee. Same to be forwarded to the Ontario Municipal Association Carried

A deputation of Rocks Point citizens waited on the Council regarding the matter of winter bus service

It was moved by Mr Mac Millan seconded by Mr Smith that a recommendation be forwarded to Gray Coach Lines that they continue for the winter months to operate a south bound bus in the mornings and a north bound bus in the evenings to Rocks Point to take care of the transportation of students attending Newmarket High School and other travellers. The Council undertakes to make all reasonable provision to keep the road clear of snow but reserves the right

To ask that the service be discontinued for any period when in their judgement the operation of buses would cause injury to the road bed. Carried

It was moved by Mr MacMillan seconded by Mr Glover that the Council retain Mr Kenneth Stiver, Newmarket as advisory solicitor for the Township of North Gwillimburg for the year 1939. Fee to be arranged. Carried

Mr Williamson of Newmarket waited on the Council. He desired to be granted a license to carry on milk business in the Municipality. The matter was laid over for further consideration

It was moved by Mr Hopkins seconded by Mr Glover and resolved that this the Council elected for 1939 accede to the request of the rate payers of Willow Beach and the surrounding country side made to and sanctioned by the Council of 1938 to obtain water lots from the Ontario Government in front of the 6th Concession. Jeremiah Sedores lot and Cecil McNeil's lot for the purpose of making a small park and that this Council approve the expenditure of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to augment what has already been collected for purposes of improving this park site and that the Council ask the Dominion Government through our representative Col W. P. Mulock to build and maintain a small dock suitable for small boats and that a copy of this resolution be sent to Col W. P. Mulock M. P. at the House of Commons at Ottawa and that the seal of the Corporation be here to attached. Carried ✓

There was also a letter before the Council from Hillsdale Dairy of Newmarket asking for a License in the Township. After the matter was thoroughly discussed on the motion of Mr Hopkins seconded by Mr Mac Millan the following resolution was passed

Resolved that Council do not see fit to grant license to any dairies other than those now licensed to sell or distribute milk in the Township of North Gwillimbury

Mr Harry Babb interviewed the Council protesting assessment for C.I. on his property. After considerable discussion the matter was left over to give Council a chance to investigate

- (1) This industry is the only means open to many of our people to enable them to provide for their families during the winter months.
- (2) To withdraw the issuing of spear licenses for lake trout on Lake Simcoe would increase the direct relief costs for the municipality and consequently to the Province as well. To many times the amount formerly expended by the municipality for direct relief.
- (3) We understand that the possibility of cancelling spear licenses for lake trout would be with the idea of increasing the possibility of taking lake trout by angling and we must stress the fact that in the tourist season of July and August lake trout have already left the shore waters some four or five miles from shore. For this reason we know that the taking of lake trout by angling during the tourist season would not be facilitated or increased by the cancelling of winter fishing privileges." (Carried)

A letter from the Salvation Army was read to the Council this asked the Council for special signs at the entrance to their property for the protection of children and the moving of speed limit signs. The Clerk was asked to write them that the Council did not consider it advisable to move the speed limit signs but granted them permission to erect suitable signs warning drivers of the presence of children.
