

Belhaven Jan 5<sup>th</sup> 1942

North Sutherland Township Council held its first regular meeting for the year 1942 at Belhaven on Monday January 5<sup>th</sup> 1942

Members present comprising the 1942 Council were Ross G. Mc Millan Reeve, Harold H. Glover, Deputy Reeve, John Smiths Councilor, Jas Nelson Councilor & Charles Graham Councilor all members having taken the oath of office and the oath of allegiance to the King

Minutes of the Council meeting of Dec 15<sup>th</sup> 1941 were read and by motion adopted.

A letter from Mrs R. G. Readeau was read congratulating the Reeve and Council on their reelection by acclamation. The Clerk was asked to acknowledge this.

Mr Ralph Seave presented a letter from Mrs T. H. Hodgson claiming a refund for oil tax on his tax bill for property in Plot 80. He maintained the road had not been oiled. Mr Angus King stated the road had been oiled in 1941 as usual. It was decided that Mr Hodgson should be notified accordingly.

Mr Fred Bruckon consulted the Council regarding an arrangement to have the Township assume the rental of property occupied by the family of J. M. Brown while on relief. Council approved.

Mrs Edith Young made a proposal to the Council to pay arrears of taxes by installments if the Council agreed to withdraw their property from the Tax roll.

Mr Jas Clark asked that the Council appeal to the Hydro to relax restrictions on installing services in cases where no new transformers were required.

Mr W. E. King of Beeton consulted the Council regarding his tender to audit 1941 accounts.

By Law No 1035 was passed to authorize the borrowing of \$30,000 from the Bank of Montreal at Miramichi.

By Law No 1035A was passed to authorize borrowing of \$7,000 from the Bank of Nova Scotia at Rutton.

It was moved by Mr Graham sec by Mr Smith that a grant of \$10.00 be given to the York County Federation of Agriculture

It was moved by Mr Smith sec by Mr Graham. That the Road Superintendent and members of the Council who wish to attend the Good Roads Convention on Feb 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> be appointed as delegates.

It was moved by Mr Graham sec by Mr Smith that the Clerk be requested to subscribe for the Municipal World for members of the Council and the Township Officers

It was moved by Mr Graham sec by Mr Smith that a notice be published in the press in support of the Victory Loan Campaign.

It was moved by Mr Graham sec by Mr Smith that the collection of dog taxes be lauded by the Township Constable who will be required to dispense dog tags and licenses and collect the tax for same.

That notice be given in the press two weeks in advance of the time set for payment also notices posted in schools and post offices.

It was decided that the by-law re Well Inspector should be amended increasing the salary to be paid James Sinclair from \$80.00 to \$100.00

It was moved by Mr Graham sec by Mr Smith that the Treasurer be requested to forward \$5.00 membership fee to the Secretary of the Good Roads Association.

The meeting thus adjourned.

Belhaven Mar 2, 1942

North Swillimburg Township Council met at Belhaven on Monday Mar 2. All the members were present except Reeve Mc Millan.

Deputy Reeve Mr Glover took the chair. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and by motion adopted.

A deputation of ladies from the various Women's Institutes in the Municipality waited on the Council.

They brought to the Council's attention the fact that the matter of municipalities being given power to provide medical services and levy for same in taxes had been brought before the Ontario Legislature. They thought this matter was of particular interest to North Swillimburg as at present there is no doctor resident in the Township and they asked if the Council would get behind the movement to have enabling legislation passed. Council agreed to do so and the Clerk was requested to write to the Minister of Public Health accordingly.

Gordon & Gerald Traviss made a proposition to sell a quantity of wood delivered and piled at the Community Hall.

By Law No 1036 was passed amending By Law No 1025 and setting salary of the Clerk at \$600.00 per year.

By Law No 1039 was passed appointing Pound Keepers Gene Viewers and Sheep Valuers.

By Law No 1037 was passed amending By Law No 1009 and setting salary of Well Inspector at \$100.00 per year.

By Law No 1038 was passed amending By Law No 1029 and appointing Mrs Noble Munro to the Community Hall Board.

By Law No 1039<sup>A</sup> was passed providing for the licensing of dogs in the Township and for enforcement of provisions of the Dog Tax and Live Stock Protection Act.

By Law No 1040 was passed appointing Carl Norman to issue Dog Licenses and Dog Tags and collect fees for same.
