To appoint two Assessors and one Sarcan Inspector for this Township for the present year. 1861

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North-Wellington and it is hereby enacted - That there be two Assessors in this Township for the present year, and that Isaac Merritt and David Willoughby be the Assessors and that they shall assess the Township in alphabetical order of the surnames.

And be it enacted that the Assessors shall foot up each Column on the Assessment Roll separately and distinctively before returning it to the Township Clerk, and such assessment Roll shall be delivered by the Assessors to the Township Clerk on or before the first day of April in the present year.

And be it further enacted that Amos Crittenden be appointed Inspector of Houses of Public Entertainment for the present year

A By-Law

To Repeal the first Clause of By Law No Seventy six

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North-Gwillimbury and it is hereby enacted that so much of the first Clause of By Law Number seventy six which relates to taxing each dog the sum of Twenty five cents be rescinded and the following substituted - That every resident Mate payer of this Township be allowed to keep one dog free of tax, and for every second dog shall pay the sum of one dollar.

And be it further enacted, That each person shall make a true return of every second dog owned by them to the assessors, in the same manner as they are required to make a return of any other taxable property.

A By-Law

To appoint a Collector for this Township for the present year 1861

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North-Wellington, that there be but one Collector in this Township in the present year, and that Elijah Prosser be the Collector and that he shall enter into bonds, separately and collectively in the sum of double the amount on the Collectors A/c, and two sureties in one half the amount required of the Township Collector each, before entering on the duties of his office, such bond to be lodged with the Township Treasurer after being approved of by the Ward.

Be it further enacted, that the above Collector shall return all the percentage that he may be authorised by the Provincial Act to receive to the Township Treasurer for Township purposes.

A B J Law

To Assess the inhabitants of this Township for general County purposes, for payment of School Teachers, for Superintendants Wages, for debentures and interest on Court house and for general Township Purposes.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North Guillemburg and it is hereby enacted, that there be raised levied and Collected on the whole rateable property of the Residents in this Township in the present year four Mills on the dollar for the above purposes, and that the Clerk be authorized to enter the same on the Collectors Coll in one Column.

And be it further enacted, that there be raised levied and Collected on the lands of Non-Residents the sum of one mill and a half on the dollar for County purposes and for the tenth instalment on Court house, also one Mill and a half on the dollar for the payment of school teachers and for superintendants wages, and also that there be raised levied and Collected on the lands of Non-Residents the sum of one Mill and a half on the dollar for general Township purposes, and that the Clerk be authorized to enter the same in three different Columns on the Collectors Coll.

To alter and amend part of By-Law No. 97

Be it enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North-Quilimbury, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same that that part of By Law Number Ninety seven which relates to the Boundaries of school sections Number one and five be altered and amended as follows that is to say: The East half of Lot Number six in the fourth Concession be detached from school section No. 1 and said half Lot attached to school section No. five said sections (with this exception) to be bounded as prescribed in By Law No. 97 this By Law to take effect from and after the twenty fifth day of December next.
