To divide this Township into Road Divisions

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of North Guillemburg, and the same is hereby enacted, That the following shall be the boundaries of the several Road Divisions viz

Division No. 1 To Commence at the Town Line of East Guillemburg then North along the main travelled road to the side road between lots No 5 & 6 and thence east said side road to the 4th Concession Line

Division No. 2 To Commence at the side road between lots No 5 & 6 then North to the side road between lots No 10 & 11 then east across said side road to the 4th Concession line.

Division No. 3 To Commence at the side road between lots No 10 & 11 then northerly to Medina then west to the Lake shore, then North along the Lake shore to the side road between lots 14 & 15

Division No. 4 To Commence at the line between lots No 14 & 15 then north along the Lake shore road to ~~No. Windhams south line including the side road~~ the line between lots 19 & 20 including the side road between lots 15 & 16 up to the Barney road

No. 114
A By Law

To restrain Certain Cattle Horses, Pigs and other animals from running at large

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North Guillemburg and it is hereby enacted that from and after the passing of this By-Law - All Horses, Colts, Bulls, Boars or pigs, of any kind Mares and Stags, of every description shall not be free Commoners nor shall not be allowed to run at large.

And be it further enacted that any Horse, Colt, Bull, Boar, Mare or Stag, found running at large the owner shall pay a fine of one Dollar each provided always that no such fine shall be inflicted unless it can be proved that such Bull, Horse, Colt, Boar, Mare, or Stag was found running at large through the neglect of the owner.

And be it further enacted, that all Hogs or Pigs found running at large may be impounded and the owner shall pay a fine of twenty five cents for each Hog, or Pig so found running at large.

And be it further enacted that the following shall be the amount of fees to be received by the Pound Keeper for food poundage advertising and selling the same.

And for animals not allowed to run at large one fourth more than other animals, for advertising & double the amount for impounding and that each animal so impounded, shall receive the following amount of food per day

 Sheep each 5 lb of Hay
 Hogs over 40 lbs weight each 1 quart of peas corn or other grain
 Hogs under 40 lbs 1 pint do
 Turkeys & Geese each 1/2 pint

And be it further enacted, That if any of the above named animals receive any damage through the neglect of the pound keeper he shall make good all such damage and the costs of the same

And be it further enacted, That such Pound Keeper may appeal in case any Cattle in his charge should receive any injury, the neglect must be proved before the Sheriff and the value of such animal, shall be confirmed by three Creditable

Creditable Freeholders or Household-ers
And be it further enacted, that this By-law
repeals all By-laws or parts of By-laws inter-
fering with this By-law.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North Guillemburg and it is hereby enacted. That there shall be raised levied and Collected on the whole rateable property of the Residents in this Township in the present year three Mills on the dollar for the above purposes. and that the Clerk be authorized to enter the same on the Collectors Roll in one Column.

And be it further enacted, That there be raised Levied and Collected on the lands of Non Residents the sum of one Mill on the dollar for County purposes and one Mill on the dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Superintendants wages; and also that there be raised levied and Collected on the Lands of Non Residents the sum of one Mill on the dollar for general Township purposes and that the Clerk be authorized to enter the same in three different Columns on the Collectors
