Therefore Be it enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the township of North Guillemburg, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

That Isaac Marritt be and is hereby appointed assessor for the township of North Guillemburg for the year 1865, and that he shall deliver the assessment roll with all the names of all persons entered thereon arranged in alphabetical order of the surnames and otherwise completed in accordance with the Statutes on or before the fifteenth day of April next ensuing, to the township clerk

And Be it further enacted that the assessor aforesaid shall be paid the sum of thirty dollars, for his services as assessor, to be paid as soon as his roll is finally revised at the Court of Revision

A By Law to divide the township of North Guillemburg into Road divisions

Be it Enacted by the Municipal Council of the township of North Guillemburg and is hereby Enacted by the authority of the same that the Several road allowances in the township shall be divided into Road divisions which said divisions shall be numbered and bounded as follows. that is to say Road divisions.

No 1

To Commence at the townline of East Guillemburg thence <sup>northerly</sup> along the third concession and the present travelled road to the side road between lots No 5 & 6 in 3<sup>d</sup> Con thence east along said side road to the 4<sup>th</sup> Con line

No 2

To Commence at the side road between lots 5 & 6 in 3<sup>d</sup> Con thence Northerly along the present travelled road to the side road between lots 10 & 11 in said 3<sup>d</sup> Con thence easterly along the said side road to the 4<sup>th</sup> Con line

No 3

To commence at the side road between lots 10 & 11 in the 3<sup>d</sup> Con thence Northerly along the present travelled road to Jug Hill thence westerly to the lake shore thence Northerly along the Lake to the line between lots 14 & 15 in 2<sup>d</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> Con.

No 4

To Commence on the 4<sup>th</sup> Town line at the road allowance which runs through lot No 23 in 3<sup>d</sup> Town thence westerly along said road allowance to where it intersects the Lake Shore road in road division No 5 thence Northerly to Capt Mays Wharf. and also to include the Old Warren road from the side road between lots No 20 & 21 Northerly to the side road in the Centre of lot No 23 in 3<sup>d</sup> Town

To Commence at Lyman Pettenden's North East corner then North to the Lake Shore thence Easterly along the Lake Shore road to the line between lots No 24 & 3 in the Lake Town

To commence at the townline of Georgina thence along the base line to the 6<sup>th</sup> Con line.

To commence at the 6<sup>th</sup> Con line thence westerly along the base line to the 5<sup>th</sup> Con line.

To commence at the 5<sup>th</sup> Con line thence westerly along the base line to the 4<sup>th</sup> Con line.

A By Law to assess the Inhabitants of the Township of North Gwillimbury for general <sup>County</sup> purposes for the payment of School Teachers; for Local Superintendents Salary and for general Township purposes for the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety <sup>one</sup> ~~five~~.

Therefore be it Enacted by the Municipality of the Township of North Gwillimbury and it is hereby Enacted by the Authority of the same that there shall be raised levied and collected on the whole rateable property of the residents of the Township in the present year the sum of Five Mills on the dollar for the above mentioned purposes that is to say one & a half Mills on the dollar for County purposes two Mills on the dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Local Superintendents Salary and two and a half Mills on the dollar for general Township purposes and the Clerk is hereby authorized to enter the same in the collectors Roll in three different Columns

And be it further enacted that there shall be raised levied and collected on the lands of Non Residents within this Municipality the sum of one and a half Mills on the dollar for County purposes; one Mill on the dollar for the payment of

School Teachers and Local Superintendents Salary and Two & a half Mills on the Dollar for General Township purposes and the Clerk is hereby authorized to enter the same on the Collectors Roll in three different columns
