A. By Law to appoint a Collector of Taxes for the year A. D. 1867

The Council of the Corporation of North Guillemburg Enacts as follows

1st That there be but one Collector the Current year and that John Purdy Esq^r be, and is hereby appointed Collector of Township Tax the Current year, and that he shall enter into Bonds Separately and Collectively in the sum of double the amount on the Collectors Roll, and two sureties in one half the amount required of the Township Collector each, before entering upon the Duties of this office, such Bonds to be lodged with the Township Treasurer after being approved of by the Council

2nd And be it further Enacted that the above Collector shall return all per Centage that he may be authorized by the Provincial Act, or by any By Law of the County Council to receive as such Collector to the Township Treasurer for Township purposes

3rd And be it further Enacted that the above named John Purdy Esq^r shall receive for his services as such Collector the sum of Twenty Dollars

By Law No 175

A By Law to require parties who have lands contiguous to roads leading through any unimproved Lands, to cut down the standing timber &c &c

Whereas the Statutes of Canada 29 & 30 Vic Cap 51 Empowers the Municipal Councils of Townships, to Pass By Laws for the purpose of causing the timber on each or either side of any road (when it is made to appear that it would be for the Benefit of any ^{such} road) to be cut down by the proprietors of such Lands

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of North Gwillimbury Enacts as follows;

That whenever it is made to appear to the said Council that it is requisite to cause the timber on each or either side of any road in this Township to be cut down that this Council shall and is required by this By Law and under the Power of the above recited Act, to cause the necessary Notice or Notices to be given to the proprietor, or proprietors, of any such Lands and otherwise use the Power thus Invested in said Council

A By Law to repeal By Laws 147 & 158 and to Divide the Township of North Guillemburg into Road Divisions

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg Enacts as follows

1st That By Laws Nos. 147 & 158 be and the same is hereby repealed

2nd That the several Road Allowances in this Township shall be divided into Road Divisions which said Road Divisions shall be numbered and bounded as follows that is to say Road Divisions

No. 1 To commence at the Townline of East and North Guillemburg thence northerly along the third Concession and the present travelled Road to the side Road between lots No. 5 & 6 in the 2nd & 3rd Concession including the side Road between lots No. 5 & 6 in the 2nd & 3rd Concession

No. 2 To commence at the side Road between lots No. 5 & 6 in the third Concession thence northerly along the present travelled Road to the side Road between lots No. 10 & 11 in the said 3rd Concession

A By Law to Assess the Inhabitants of the Township of North Gwillimbury for General County Purposes; for the Payment of School Teachers, for Local Superintendants Salary and for General Township Purposes

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury Enacts as follows

1st That there shall be raised levied and collected on the whole rateable property of the residents of this Township in the present year ~~the~~ sum of Two and one half Mills on the Dollar for the above mentioned purposes, that is to say one mill on the Dollar for County purposes one half mill on the Dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Local Superintendants Salary, and one mill on the Dollar for General Township purposes, and the Clerk is hereby authorized to enter the same on the Collectors Roll in three different Columns

2nd And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that there shall be raised levied and collected on the Lands of Nonresidents within this Municipality the sum of one mill on the Dollar for County Purposes one half mill on the Dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Local Superintendants Salary and one mill on the Dollar for General Township purposes and the Clerk is hereby authorized and required to enter ^{the same on} the Collectors Roll in
