By-Law No. 190

A By-Law to appoint a Collector of taxes in the Township of North Guilford for the year 1868

The Council of the Corporation of North Guilford enacts as follows

That there be but one Collector for the current year and that Frances Morton be and is hereby appointed Collector of taxes for the Township aforesaid for the current year; and that he shall enter into bonds separately and collectively in the sum of double the amount on the Collectors roll for the present year, and two sureties, each in half the amount required of the said Collector. Before entering upon the duties of his office such bonds to be properly executed and lodged with the Township Treasurer after being approved of by this Council.

And be it further enacted that the abovementioned Collector shall return all percentage to the Township Treasurer for Township purposes, that he may be entitled to by any Legislative Enactment of the Dominion of Canada, or of the Province of Ontario, or by authority of any By-Law of the County of York.

Statute Labour for the year 1868

A By-Law to amend By-Laws Nos 180 & 188

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that there be a Road Division formed commencing at the Northern Limits of Lot No. 11 on the Fifth Concession Line, thence South along the said Concession line to the Side Road between 5 & 6 and that William ^{Coomey} be and he is hereby appointed Overseer of Highways for said Road Division that shall be known as division No. 46

Therefore be it enacted and it is hereby enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg, that the trees shall, for a space of Twenty-five feet on each side of the highway crossing Lot Number Seven in the Sixth Concession of the Township of North Guillemburg, aforesaid be cut down and removed by the proprietor of the said Lot within Four months from and after the passing of this By-Law

And be it further enacted by the Council above mentioned, that if the Proprietor of the said land shall fail to cut down and remove the trees within the time above specified; then the Overseer of Highways for the time being, in whose Division the land lies shall cause the trees to be cut down and removed for any purpose connected with the improvement of Highways and Bridges in his division; or to be sold by him to defray the expence of carrying this By-Law into effect

As By-Law to assess the Ratepayers of the Township of North Guillemburg for General County Purposes, for the payment of School Teachers, for Local Superintendants Salary, and for general Township purposes.

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows. - That there shall be levied and collected on the whole rateable property of the residents of this Township in the present year the sum of Two and one half mills on the Dollar for the above mentioned purposes, that is to say one mill and one quarter on the Dollar for County purposes, Three quarters of a mill on the Dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Local Superintendants Salary, and one half mill on the Dollar for general Township purposes, and the Clerk is hereby authorized and required to enter the same on the Collectors Roll in Three different columns.

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that there shall be raised levied and collected on the lands of Nonresidents within this Municipality the sum of one mill and one quarter on the Dollar for County purposes, Three quarters of a mill on the Dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Local Superintendants Salary, and one half mill on the Dollar for general Township purposes, and that the Clerk is hereby authorized and required to enter the same on the Collectors Roll in three different columns.

By-Law No. 199

A By-Law to Close up a Road in the Town Plot of
Hesswick in the Township of North Guilford.

Whereas by provision of the Statute 29th and 30th Vic
Cap. 51 of Upper Canada power is given to Township
Municipal Councils to close up Highways when no
longer required for public travel.

Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the
Corporation of the Township of North Guilford
and it is hereby enacted, that the road in the Town Plot
of Hesswick; Commencing at the intersection of
Boucher Street with Gill Street, thence in a
North Westerly direction across a block of land
owned by Rev. Walter Stennett, and continued in
the same direction across a block of land owned
by Robert McCordick Esq. on the North side of Main
Street, to where it intersects with the road on the
South side of Lot No. 23 in the Second Concession
of the said Township: That the Notices being
given as required by the 323rd Sec. Sub Sections
Nos. one and two of the above mentioned Act, the
above described road is hereby closed from and
after the passing of this By-Law.

A By-Law passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury for the purpose of forming a new School Section and for alteration in the boundaries of other Sections herein specified

Therefore be it enacted by the Council aforesaid and it is hereby enacted, that from and after the passing of this By-Law a new School Section be formed within the above mentioned Municipality known as School Section Number Seven, and that the boundaries thereof shall be as follows; Commencing at the Town Line between North Gwillimbury and Georgia on the limits between Lots Nos. 10 & 11 then West to the centre of the Sixth Concession. Then North to the Side Line between Lots number Twenty and Twenty-one. Then East to the Seventh Concession Line. Then North along the said Seventh Concession Line to the Base Line. Then East to the Town Line. Then South along the said Town Line to the place of beginning. - And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that Edwin Aldon be and he is hereby appointed to hold the First School Meeting according to Law for the election of Trustees in said School Section.

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that Lots number Nine and Ten in the Fifth Concession of the said Township of North Gwillimbury be detached from School Section Number Four and added to School Section Number Five.
