By-Law No 205

To make Rules and Regulations for governing the proceedings of the Incorporation of the Township of North Guillemburg

Whereas it is expedient to make regulations for the working of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg

Therefore the said Corporation enacts as follows; that from and after the passing of this By-Law the following rules and regulations shall be adopted as the standing Rules and Regulations of this body Corporate

1 That it shall be the duty of the Reeve or Chairman to preserve order and decorum, and to see that the following rules are strictly adhered to and complied with; And any person or persons whether members of this Council or others violating any of said rules or refusing or neglecting to obey when called to order by the Reeve or Chairman shall be dealt with and fined according to consolidated By-Law No 1 passed October 27th 1860

2 That this Council do meet at Ten O'clock in the forenoon unless otherwise specially provided, and if at Ten O'clock there is no quorum the Reeve or Chairman may take the chair and adjourn with the consent of the majority of the members then present.

3 That whenever the Reeve or Chairman is obliged to adjourn the Council for want of a quorum the hour at which such adjournment is made and the names of the members present shall be inserted in the minutes of the Council.

4 In case the Reeve shall not be in attendance the Clerk shall call the meeting to order untill a chairman be chosen who shall preside untill the arrival of the Reeve or untill adjournment of the meeting.

5 That immediately after the Reeve or Chairman shall have taken the chair the minutes of the preceding meeting shall be read by the Clerk to the end that any mistake therein can be corrected by the Council.

- 6 That every member who shall be present when a question is put in Council shall vote thereon, unless the Council shall excuse him and the yeas and nays shall be taken on such question.
- 7 The minutes of the council shall consist of a record of the names of all the members present at any meeting of the council and of all the proceedings taken in council.
- 8 That when two or more members shall address the Reeve or Chairman at one time he shall name the member who is first to speak.
- 9 That when the Reeve or Chairman is putting a question no member shall walk out of or across the Council hall nor when a member is speaking shall any person hold discourse to interrupt him except by order.
- 10 That a motion to adjourn shall always be in order.
- 11 That in committee a motion that the Chairman leave the chair shall always be in order and shall take the place of any other motion without debate.
- 12 That no motion except for adjournment, for going into committee of the whole, or for receiving reports, or petitions shall be debated or put, unless the same is in writing and seconded.
- 13 That in forming a committee of the whole Council the Reeve or Chairman before leaving the chair shall appoint a Chairman to preside who shall have the same authority in the chair of the committee as the Reeve in the chair of the Council except deciding questions of order.
- 14 On motion in committee to rise and report the question shall be decided without debate.
- 15 That when the Reeve or Chairman takes his chair and the members take their seats no person shall walk across the room; nor when any member is speaking shall any one hold any discourse to interrupt him.

16 That no person shall be dictating to the Council without permission from the Reeve or Chairman and that any one called to order shall sit down so as not to interrupt the Council.

17 That all Petitions to this Council shall be presented by a ^{member of this Council} ~~representative of this Municipality~~, who shall be answerable to this Council that they do not contain any improper or impertinent matter and that and that no petition be received later than Twelve O'clock noon at any session of this Council

18 That no bad language shall be used by any person in the Council Chamber

19 That every member of this Council in reading any Resolution, Petition, or other document or speaking on any subject shall rise on his feet and continue standing while addressing the chair

20 That no smoking shall be allowed in the Council room during the business of the Council

21 That no person shall have their hat or cap on in the Council Chamber during the sessions of this Council.

By-Law No 206

A By-Law passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury for the purpose of amending Consolidated By-Law No. Eight of said Municipality

Therefore be it enacted by authority of the said Council that Section Number Two, Three, Seven, & Ten of the above mentioned Consolidated By-Law No. 8 be and they are hereby repealed

And be it further enacted that in lieu of the above mentioned Section No. Two of By-Law No. 8 the following shall be substituted. That the amount to be paid to the Treasurer of the said Municipality of North Gwillimbury for a Tavern License shall be Twenty Dollars and for a Shop License Forty Dollars over and above the Provincial Duty.

And be it further enacted that in lieu of the above mentioned Section No. 3 of Consolidated By-Law No. 8 the following shall be substituted. That the Tavern Inspector shall, upon order of the Council, inspect the premises of any person who have petitioned the Council for a License and if they are found to have all the qualifications required by "The Tavern and Shop License Act of 1869" and of this By-Law he shall certify the same to the Reeve, whereon the Reeve and Clerk shall grant the applicant a certificate as provided by the Fourteenth Section of the above mentioned License Act.

And be it further enacted that By-Law No. 189 of this Municipality is hereby repealed

By-Law No 207

A By Law passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury for closing and disposing of the original Road allowance or Concession allowance in front of Lot Number Five in The Third Concession.

Whereas by the Consolidated Statutes of Upper Canada Chapter Fifty-four and also by 29th and 30th Vic. Chapter 51 Sec 323 authority is given to Municipal Councils to pass By-Laws for the closing and disposing of original Road Allowances when no longer required for public travel.

And Whereas Michael Hodgins has petitioned the said Township Council to have conveyed to him the original Road Allowance in front of Lot Number Five in the Third Concession of the Township of North Gwillimbury in lieu of the Public Road now travelled across the said Lot.

And Whereas James Anderson and John Hodgins the present proprietors of the said Lot Number Five in the Third Concession, have by signing the said petition represented to the Council of North Gwillimbury that they wish the said Road Allowance to be conveyed to the said Michael Hodgins on such Conditions as they (the Council) may consider just and lawful.

And Whereas Public notice has been given as required by the Statute 29th and 30th Vic. Chapter 51 Sec. 323 of the intention of the Council to pass a By-Law for closing and disposing of the said Road Allowance.

Be it therefore enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury by authority of the above mentioned Provincial Enactment, and it is hereby enacted that after the passing of this By-Law and after it has been confirmed by the Council of the County of York

according to Law: The Reeve of the Municipality of North
Gwillimbury on behalf of the Corporation and under the
Corporate seal of the Municipality shall convey by deed in
fee simple to the said Michael Hodgins of the Township
of North Gwillimbury in the County of York and Province
of Ontario, former, his heirs and assigns for ever, all
the original Road Allowance between the Second and
Third Concessions and in front of Lot Number Five in
the the said Third Concession of North Gwillimbury
be the same more or less. And may be otherwise known
and described as follows, that is to say, Commencing at
the South West angle of Lot Number Five, then Northerly
along the Western Line of the said Lot Number Five and
the Eastern Line the said original Road Allowance Twenty
Chains more or less to the Side Road between Lots
Number Five and Six. Then Westerly along the Side Road
one chain more or less to the rear of the Second
Concession. Then Southerly along the Western line of
the original Road Allowance Seventy Chains more or
less to the limits between Lots Number Four and
Five. Then Easterly one chain more or less to the
place of beginning containing about Two Acres of
land, be the same more or less, in consideration
of the present travelled Road crossing the said Lot
Number Five and also in consideration of the Dollar
of lawful money of the Province of Ontario.

And be it further enacted by the said
Municipality that the above mentioned Applicant
Michael Hodgins shall pay all expenses attending
the conveyance of the above mentioned land.

By-Law No. 208

A By-Law to amend By-Law No. 204 of the Township of North Guillemburg, and also to amend By-Law No. 180

Whereas it becomes necessary to appoint some person in place of William Moore as overseer of Road Division No. 2 and George Burrows of Road Division No. 32

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of North Guillemburg that Joseph Moore be appointed Overseer of Highways for Road Division No. 2 and also Neha Burrows be appointed Overseer of Highways for Road Division No. 32 for the present year.

And be it further enacted by authority of the said Municipal Council that By-Law No. 108 of the said Municipal Council be amended by making a new road Division composed of part of Road Division Nos 3 & 4, which new Road Division shall commence at the Side Road between Lots 15 & 16 on the Lake Shore Road and then South along the Lake Shore to the Road between Lots 13 & 14 in the 2nd & 3rd Con. and then East along the said Road to Samuel Trelores West corner and that William Collins be appointed overseer of said Road Division that shall be known as Road Division No. 47.

And be it further enacted by authority of the said Municipal Council that By-Law No. 204 be amended by appointing Richard A. Sheppard Pound Keeper in the Township of North Guillemburg

By-Law No. 209

A By-Law passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg for the purpose of dividing the Township into Subdivisions for polling purposes.

Whereas by provision of the Statutes of Ontario 32nd Vic. Chap. 21 Municipal Councils are authorized and required to divide Municipalities into Polling Subdivisions whenever the number of qualified voters ^{therein} shall exceed Two Hundred.

Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg and it is hereby enacted, that from and after the passing of this By-Law the said Township of North Guillemburg is divided into Two Polling Subdivisions as follows.

Subdivision No 1 to be composed of the Western part of said Township and bounded as follows; Commencing at the South West angle of the said Township then Easterly along the South line of said Township to the Fifth Concession line, then Northerly along the Fifth Concession line to the Lake Concession, then Westerly along the Side Road between ~~Lot Number~~ Lake Concession otherwise called the Base Line, to the Side Road between Lot Number Five and Six in the Lake Concession, then Northerly along the said Side Road to the Lake Shore then following the Lake Shore Westerly and Southerly to Roaches Point, then Southerly following the Lake Shore to the Western limits of the Township, then Southerly along the Western limits to the place of beginning.

Subsection No. 2 to be composed of the Eastern part of said Township and bounded as follows: ^{beginning} Commencing on the South Line of said Township where it intersects the Fifth Concession Line, then Northerly along the said Fifth Concession Line to the Lake Concession, otherwise called the Base Line, then Westerly along the said line to the Side Road between lots number Five and Six in the Lake Concession, then Northerly along the said Side Road between the Lake Simcoe or the Northern limits of the said Township, then Easterly along the Lake Shore to the Eastern limits of the said Township, then South-
erly along the Eastern limits of said Township to the South East Angle, then Westerly along the South line of said Township to the place of beginning.

By-Law No 210

A By-Law for appointing a Collector of taxes in the Township of North Gwillimbury for the year 1869.

The Council of the Corporation of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows.

That there be but one collector for this Township for the current year and that John Prosser be and he is hereby appointed Collector of taxes for this Township aforesaid for the current year, and that he shall enter into bonds separately and collectively in the sum of double the amount on the Collectors Roll for the present year and two sureties each in half the amount required of the said Collector.

Before entering upon the duties of his office such bonds to be properly executed and lodged with the Townships Treasurer after being approved of by the Reeve.

And be it further enacted that ~~the~~ the abovementioned Collector shall return all per. centage to the Townships Treasurer for township purposes, that he may be entitled to by any Legislative Enactment of the Dominion of Canada, or of the Province of Ontario or by authority of any By-Law of the County of York.

And be it further enacted that the said John Prosser shall receive from this Municipality Council Twenty Dollars as his Salary in full for his services as such Collector.

By-Law No. 211

A By-Law to assess the Malepayers of the Township of North Guillemburg for General County purposes, for the payment of School Teachers, for Local Superintendants Salary and for General Township purposes.

The Council of the Corporation of North Guillemburg enacts as follows; That there shall be levied and collected on the whole rateable property of the residents of this Township in the present year the sum of Four Mills on the Dollar for the abovementioned purposes. That is to say one Mill and one half on the Dollar for County purposes. One Mill on the Dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Local Superintendants Salary, and one Mill and one half on the Dollar for General Township purposes.

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that there shall be levied and collected on the lands of Nonresidents within this Municipality the sum of one Mill and one half on the Dollar for County purposes, one Mill on the Dollar for the payment of School Teachers and Local Superintendants Salary, and one Mill and one half on the Dollar for General Township purposes, and that the Clerk is hereby required to enter the same on the Collectors Roll in three different columns
