A By-Law, to Divide the Township of North Guillemburg into Road Divisions and to define the boundaries of the same

Whereas it is necessary and expedient that the several Road Allowances in the Township of North Guillemburg should be divided into Road Divisions and be more particularly bounded and defined

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows,

That the several Road Allowances in the said Township shall be divided into Road Divisions, and shall be numbered and bounded as follows, That is to say: Road Division

A By Law to Assess the Rateable Property of the Township of North Guillemburg, for General County Purposes, for the Payment of School Teachers for School Superintendents Salary, School Inspector and Examiners, and for General Township Purposes.

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows, ~~That is to say~~: That there shall be levied and collected on the whole Rateable Property of the Resident Assessed Ratepayers of the aforesaid Township in the present year, the sum of three Mills on the dollar for the above mentioned Purposes, That is to say: one Mill on the dollar for County Purposes, three fourths of a Mill on the dollar, for the Payment of School Teachers, Local Superintendents, School Inspector, and School Examiners Salary, and one Mill and one fourth in the dollar for General Township Purposes.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That there shall be raised, levied and collected, on the lands of Non Residents Assessed, within the Municipality aforesaid, for the present year, the sum of three Mills on the dollar, That is to say: one Mill on the dollar for County Purposes, three fourths of a Mill on the dollar for the Payment of School Teachers, Local Superintendents, School Inspector and School Examiners Salary, and one Mill and one fourth on the dollar, for General Township Purposes.
