Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the
Corporation of the Township of North Ferrisburgh
And it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid

By Law No. 263

A By Law, Making it the duty of every Overseer of highways, to impound all Hogs running at large in the Road Division over which they are such Overseers,

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilfimbury enacts as follows:

That every Overseer of Road Divisions within the Township of North Guilfimbury shall, from and after the passing of this By Law, impound all Hogs found running at large in the Road Division over which he, or they have been appointed such Overseer, and that they receive one half of the fine imposed upon the Owners of such Hogs impounded.

And be it further enacted, that every Overseer of highways, refusing or neglecting to perform such duty, shall be subject to a fine of two dollars, to be collected in accordance with Consuetudine By Law, Number one of the aforesaid Township

By Law No. 264

A By Law to authorize and empower the Trustees of School Section Number two in the Township of North Guillemburg to borrow the sum of one thousand dollars for the purpose of building a school house in said section.

Whereas it is necessary that a new school house should be built in school section Number two in the Township of North Guillemburg,

And

Whereas it is necessary and right that the Trustees of said section should have the privilege of borrowing the sum of one thousand dollars for the above purpose

And

Whereas the Common school act of 1860 section 35. gives power to Municipal Councils to authorize and empower Trustees of School sections to borrow money for similar purposes

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows: That, the Trustees of School Section Number two in the aforesaid Township of North Guillemburg be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow the sum of one thousand dollars (on the credit of said school section) for the term of two years from the thirty first day of December next, to be paid in two equal annual installments of five hundred dollars each, with interest.

A By Law to Appoint a Collector of taxes for the Township of North Gwillimbury, for the year 1875.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury, enact as follows,

1. That there be a collector appointed for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the present year (1875) and that Franklin Merton, be, and he is hereby appointed such Collector of taxes for the Township aforesaid for the current year, and that he shall, before entering upon the duties of said office, enter into a bond with two good and sufficient sureties to be approved by the Council of this Municipality himself in the amount appearing on the Collector's Roll for the present year, and the sureties each, in one half the amount, which bond shall be made payable (either jointly or severally) to the Treasurer of this Municipality.

2. And be it further enacted, that the said collector shall pay over to the Treasurer of the said Municipality of North Gwillimbury all money that he may receive, by virtue of his office as such collector.

3. And be it further enacted that the said collector shall receive the sum of forty dollars as his salary in full for his services as such collector.

A By Law to Assess for County Purposes, for General Township Purposes, for the Payment of School Teachers, Inspectors, Examiners, and for High School Purposes,
