By Law No. 274

A By Law to Appoint an Officer to enforce the observance of the Statutes and Municipal By Laws with reference to Tavern and Shop Licenses; And to fix and define his duties.

Whereas, by 36<sup>th</sup> Vic. Cap. 34 - sec 8 Municipal Councils are required to appoint an Officer to enforce the observance of the Provincial Statutes and Municipal By Laws with reference to Tavern and Shop Licenses, and to define their duties, and remuneration to be paid to said Officer.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury, That Thomas Bennett be, and he is hereby appointed to the Office referred to in the Preamble to this By Law.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, that it shall be the duty of such Officer to use all diligence in endeavoring to see that the Provincial Statutes, and also the Municipal By Laws (so far as relates to this Municipality) are strictly adhered to, and observed, and to take Legal Proceedings against any Party or Parties found violating the same.

And be it further enacted that it shall be the duty of said Officer in Addition to the duties hereinbefore enumerated to perform all the duties now devolving upon the License Inspector and shall be known as Inspector of Tavern and Shop Licenses.

And be it further enacted that the said  
License Inspector receive the sum of ten  
dollars as his salary for his service as such  
Inspector of Tavern and Shop License, And,  
in case of any Conviction by Complaint  
arising in consideration of said duties he  
(said Inspector) shall receive a fair remuneration  
for time necessarily employed.

By Law No. 277.

A By Law to appropriate a portion of the amount of the Municipal Loan fund, due to the Township of North Quillimbury, for the building of Bridges in the said Municipality.

Whereas, by an Act Passed, by the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, 36<sup>th</sup> Vic Cap. 47 Sec. 12413 Municipal Councils are authorized and empowered to Pass By Laws appropriating their Apportionment of the Municipal Loan fund, to be applied to the building of Bridges and other Permanent Works, And —

Whereas, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Quillimbury, have already entered into Contracts for the building of two large Bridges in the said Municipality, (and the work is progressing) for the respective sums of five hundred and twenty five dollars, and nine hundred and sixty five dollars;

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Quillimbury enacts as follows:  
That the sum of fifteen hundred and twenty dollars of the Appropriation of the Municipal Loan fund due to the said Municipality of the Township of North Quillimbury, be set apart for that purpose, and applied for the Payment of the Bridges referred to, in the Preamble to this By Law.

A By Law to Appoint a Collector of Taxes for the Township of North Guillemburg for the Current year

1 The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows:

By-Law No. 283

A By-Law to appropriate a portion of the Amount of the Municipal Loan fund due to the Township of North Gwillimbury, for the Payment of Debenture and Interest now due on account of the Bonus granted to the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway

Whereas by an Act Passed by the Legislature of the Province of Ontario, 36<sup>th</sup> Vic. Cap. 47. Sec<sup>s</sup> 12 & 13 Municipal Councils are authorized and empowered to Pass By-Laws appropriating their Apportionment of the Municipal Loan fund to be Applied to the building of Bridges and other Permanent Works.

And

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the County of York, has Passed a By-Law authorizing the levying and Collecting the sum of sixty two Mills and sixty two hundred<sup>th</sup> of a Mill on the dollar from all Property rated on the Assessment Rolls of the Township of Georgina, North Gwillimbury, and a Portion of East Gwillimbury for Paying Debenture and Interest on account of the Bonus granted to the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway.

Whereas the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury are indebted on account of such Railway Bonus to the Amount of one thousand and fifty two<sup>100</sup> dollars.

That the sum of one thousand and fifty two<sup>100</sup> dollars of the Apportionment of the Municipal Loan fund due to the said Municipality of the Township of North Gwillimbury be set Apart for that Purpose, and Applied for the Payment of the aforesaid indebtedness.
