By Law No. 330.

A By Law to Divide the Township of North Guilford into Road Divisions and to define the boundaries of the same, and to repeal all By Laws inconsistent therewith

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of North Guilford
And it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid
That the several Road Allowance in the said Township
shall be divided into Road Divisions, and shall be bounded and numbered as follows —
That is to say: Road Division:

No. 1

To Commence at the Township Line between East and North Guilford, where it intersects the third Concession line. Thence northward along the said third Concession line and the now traveled Road to the side Road between Lots No. 5 & 6 in the 2nd & 3rd Concession including the side Road between Lots No. 5 & 6 in the 2nd & 3rd Concession, to the Centre of the third Concession.

No. 2

To Commence at the side Road between Lots 5 & 6 in the 3rd Concession. Thence northward along the present traveled Road to the side Road between Lot 10 & 11 in the said 3rd Concession. Thence East to the Centre of the 3rd Con.

A By Law to Authorise the Reeve and
and Treasurers to borrow a certain Amount
of Money, to be Applied for Municipal Purposes

Whereas, on Account of An unusual, and
an unexpected expenditure of Money
has unavoidably, been made in the
Corporation during the Present year

And

Whereas it has become necessary to
borrow and raise a certain Amount
of Money, to defray expenses of the Municipality

And

Whereas the Statutes of the Province of
Ontario, makes Provisions for, and
Authorises Municipal Councils to borrow
Money in certain Cases,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the
Corporation of the Township of North Quillemburg
enacts as follows, That the Reeve and Treasurers
be, and they are hereby Authorised and
empowered to borrow any Amount of
Money (not exceeding the sum of five
hundred dollars) at the Credit of the
Municipality aforesaid, and that they be Authorised
to Attach the seal of the Corporation to any
Instrument necessary for that Purpose

For the better Care and Protection of Road-Scrapers

The Municipal Council of the Township of North Guilford enacts, and it is hereby enacted, as follows,

No 1

That all Road Scrapers belonging to the Municipality shall be Delivered to Myron Silver at Bell Haven, by the 15th day of July 1877. for such service, each Party shall receive the sum of $\frac{75}{100}$ seventy five cents and that after the 15th day of July, the Clerk be instructed and is hereby instructed to Prosecute all Persons found in illegal Possession of Road-scrapers, belonging to this Township

That Myron Silver be instructed to see that all Road scrapers so collected (that is worth it) are thoroughly repaired and numbered, and to keep them subject to the Clerks written Order.

3

That the Clerk be, and is hereby instructed, in issuing Road Scrapers to the different Pathmasters to take Receipt stating, No. of Scraper so issued, and the Pathmaster is hereby instructed that he shall not give it up to any one without Receipt stating No. and state of Repair. And every Pathmaster when he makes his return of Statute Labour Performed shall state No. of Road Scrapers, in his Possession, or give Receipt of Persons holding it

Councils to reduce the Statute labour

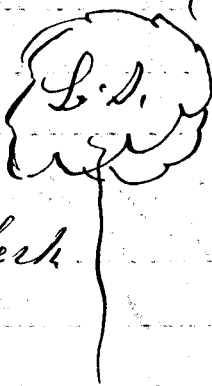

By Law No. 334

A By Law to Assess for County Purposes, for General Township Purposes, for Payment of School Teachers, and, on Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company and for Part Payment of Teacher in Amice School Section North Quillimbury & Georgina

Whereas the Act, 36th Vic. Entitled an Act Respecting Municipal Institutions of Ontario, gives Power to Municipal Councils to levy and Collect Rates for the Above named Purposes.

And

Whereas it is necessary that Certain Amounts should be raised in the Township of North Quillimbury

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Quillimbury and it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid that there be levied and Collected from all the Property rated on the Assessment Roll for the Township of North Quillimbury, liable to Assessment for the Present year, the sum of five thousand, three hundred and forty dollars and sixty cents. To be levied and Collected as follows, That is to say:

One Mill on the dollar for County Purposes.
One, and one fourth Mill on the dollar for General Township Purposes.
One half of a Mill on the dollar for Payment of School Teachers.
One, and one eighth Mill on the dollar for Payment of Debenture and Interest on Railway Bonds on County By Law. And,
One, and seven eighths of a Mill on the dollar for Payment of Debenture and Interest on Account of the Bonds Granted to the Lake Simcoe Company Junction Railway Company by Township Council.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid
that there be levied and collected from all the
Rateable Property rated on the Assessment Roll
aforesaid for the present year, in that portion
of Union School Section Number one, North
Guillimbury, And Georgia within the aforesaid
Township of North Guillimbury, the sum of
twenty nine dollars and sixty cents, as required
by Trustees of said section, (it being four mills
to the dollar)
