A By Law to Appoint a Director for the
Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company
and to repeal By Law No. 328.

Whereas by 36 Vic. (Cap. 75. Sec 20. Statutes of
Ontario, Power is given to Municipalities Granting
aid (to the amount of twenty thousand dollars)
to Railway Companies to Appoint a Director
of said Company.

By Law No. 339

A By Law to authorize and empower the Reeve to appoint an Arbitrator in the case of Sturrett v. S. the Corporation of North Gwillimbury.

Whereas a certain difficulty has arisen between George Sturrett and the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury,

and

Whereas the Municipal Institutions Act, of Ontario, makes provision for the settlement of disputes between Municipal Corporations and Private individuals with reference to lands taken for Roads and authorizes the appointment of Arbitrators by Councils, or the head thereof for the settlement of such disputes.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows, That the Reeve be, and he is hereby authorized and instructed to appoint an Arbitrator to arbitrate for and in behalf of this Corporation in the matter of dispute between George Sturrett and this Corporation concerning land taken by this Corporation for Roads, when circumstances require action in the matter.

By Law No. 341

A By Law to Make Slight Alterations in the boundary Lines of School Sections Nos 1-2-3-5 & 7. in the Township of North Quillimbury.

By Law No. 342

A By Law to Amend By Law No. 330 dividing the Township into Road Divisions.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of North Gwillimbury enacts that By Law Number three hundred and thirty be, and it is hereby amended as follows,

1st That Road Divisions Number five, and twenty eight be, and they are hereby consolidated in one Division, said Road Division to be known as Road Division No. 5.

2nd That Road Divisions Number twelve and forty nine be, and they are hereby consolidated in one Division, to be known as as Road Division No. 12.

3rd That Clause (or Road Division) Number seven be amended by striking out all after the word the, in the second line from the bottom of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following words viz. New line of Road between Lots No. 27 & 28. thence easterly along the newly established road to the 4th Concession Line.

4th That Clauses Number ^{thirty} one, and twenty nine be amended by detaching the North east Quarter of Lot Number twenty from Road Division No. 31 and attaching the same to Road Division No. 29.

5th That Clause Number thirteen be repeated and the following be substituted in lieu thereof To commence at the Base line; thence Northwesterly along the Side Road between Lots No. 54 & 6 to the New Road as surveyed by Peter Gibson M.P.S. thence west to the 4th Concession, thence Northwesterly to the Lake shore. By Law No. 346

A By Law to Authorise and empower the Trustees of School Section No. 1. in the Township of North Quillimbury, to borrow the sum of three hundred dollars for the Purpose of Paying for school site. Moving and Repairing school House &c.

Whereas the Trustees of School Section Number one in the Township of North Quillimbury, have purchased a site for a school House, (contracted for the removal and repair of the school House in said section, and other repairs

And

Whereas it has become necessary for the Trustees of said section to borrow money for the Payment of the expenses Above named.

And

Whereas the Consolidated Statutes of Ontario Cap. 204 sec. 78. sub. sec. 9. Makes it the duty of Township Councils to Pass By Laws empowering School Trustees to borrow money for the aforesaid Purposes.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Quillimbury enacts as follows: That the Trustees of school Section Number one in the Township of North Quillimbury be, and they are hereby Authorised, and empowered to borrow the sum of three hundred dollars (on the credit of said school section) for the Term of one year, and for the aforesaid Purposes

By Law No. 347

A By Law to Assess for County Purposes for General Township Purposes, for Payment of School Teachers, and, on Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company, and, for Part Payment of Teachers, in Union School Sections, North Quilkinbury, & Georgina

Whereas the 36th Vic. Entitled an Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Ontario, gives Power to Municipal Councils to levy, and Collect Rates for the Above Named Purposes.

And
Whereas it is necessary that certain Amounts should be raised in the Township of North Quilkinbury.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Quilkinbury and it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid that there be levied and collected from all the Property Rated on the Assessment Roll, for the Township of North Quilkinbury, liable to Assessment for the Present year, The sum of five thousand four hundred and sixty three dollars and sixty seven cents, To be levied and collected as follows, That is to say: One Mill on the dollar for County Purposes, One and one fourth Mills on the dollar for General Township Purposes, One half Mill on the dollar for Payment of School Teachers, One, and one fourth of a Mill on the dollar for Payment of Debenture and Interest on Railway Bonds, on County By-Laws, and, two Mills on the dollar for Payment of Debenture, and

And Interest on Account of the Bonus granted
to the Lake Simcoe Railway Company by
the Township Council.

And, be it further enacted by the
Authority aforesaid, that there be levied
and collected from all the rateable Property
rated on the Assessment Roll aforesaid
for the Present year, in that portion of
Union School section, Number one,
North Gwillimbury, and Georgina, within
the aforesaid Township of North Gwillimbury,
a rate of four Mills on the dollar, as
required by the Trustees of said school
section.
