By Law No. 351

A By Law for the better care and  
Protection of Road scrapers

Whereas it has become necessary and requisite  
that some better and more effectual Plan  
for the Protection and Keeping of the Road  
Scrapers of this Municipality be Adopted,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the  
Corporation of the Township of North  
Georgetown enacts as follows:

- 1 That it shall be the duty of the Reeve (or Person  
employed by him) to make diligent search, and  
collect all the Road scrapers belonging to this  
Municipality, and to hand them over to, or place  
them in the charge of the Person hereinafter  
Appointed to take Charge of such road scrapers
- 2 That it shall be the duty of such Person so  
Appointed to take Charge of the road scrapers, to  
number them, see that they are kept in repair  
and one of them handed over to any Overseer  
of Highways in this Municipality (when required  
to expend labour on the Road) taking his  
receipt for the same, and to report any  
violation of this By Law, to the Reeve  
immediately after such violation shall  
have taken place
- 3 That James Newburn be, and he is  
hereby Appointed to take Charge of such  
Road Scrapers, and to hold Office during  
Pleasure

That any person being found with one of the Road Scrapers belonging to this Municipality (after the first day of May next) in his possession shall be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars, To be Prosecuted in accordance with (Consolidated By Law No. 1 of this Municipality,

And that By Law No. 332 be, and it is hereby repealed.

# By Law No. 353

A By Law to Repeat By Law No. 342, & To Amend By Law No. 330.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows.

1<sup>st</sup> That By Law Number three hundred and forty two be, and it is hereby repeated,

2<sup>nd</sup> By Law Number three hundred and thirty be amended as follows:

That clauses Number one, five, six, seven, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fifteen, twenty four, thirty, thirty one, forty, forty four, and forty six be repealed, and that the following be inserted in lieu thereof, *viz*

For No. 1 To Commence at the Town Line at East Gwillimbury on Queen Street Road, then westerly along said Road, to the side Road between Lots No<sup>s</sup> 5 & 6, including said side Road in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Concessions

No. 5 To Commence at side Road (or Bass Line) (Centre of Lot No. 23. Then southerly along the Lake Shore road to the line between Lots No<sup>s</sup> 19 & 20 Con. 2, including side road between Lake Shore and Oranby Road, and also all roads now open in the Town Plat of Keswick.

No. 6 To Commence at Mays Gate, then southerly, to the Bass Line, thence easterly along the said Road to the line dividing Lots No<sup>s</sup> 2 & 3 in the Lake Concession

No. 7 To Commence on the Oranby Road at the side road in the Centre of Lot No. 23 westerly to the Lake Shore Road, easterly, to the fifth Concession

No. 11 To Commence on the 4<sup>th</sup> Concession at the side road between Lots No<sup>s</sup> 5 & 6, Con. 3. Thence westerly to the Mississauga River,

Lot No. 12 To Commence on the 5<sup>th</sup> Concession at the Side-Road between Lots No<sup>s</sup> 20 & 21, Thence Northwesterly to the Base-line Thence Westwesterly to the Line between Lots No<sup>s</sup> 2 & 3 in the Lake Concession.

No. 13 To Commence on the Base-line on the 5<sup>th</sup> Con. Thence Northwesterly to the Lake shore, said beat to include such Part of New Survey Road as left open.

No. 19 To Commence on South Town Line at 3<sup>rd</sup> Con. Thence Easterly to the 4<sup>th</sup> Con. Thence Northwesterly to the line between Lot 5 & 6 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Concession.

No. 24 To Commence on the 6<sup>th</sup> Con. at the Line between Lots No<sup>s</sup> 6 & 7 in the 5<sup>th</sup> Concession, then Northwesterly to the side Road between Lots 10 & 11.

No. 30 To Commence on the Stage Road at the 6<sup>th</sup> Con. Thence Easterly to the 7<sup>th</sup> Con. Thence Northwesterly to the line between Lots 20 & 21.

No. 31 To Commence on Stage Road at the 7<sup>th</sup> Con. Easterly to the Town Line, together with side road between Lots 20 & 21. east of said Road.

No. 40 To Commence at Town Line (on Centre Road) of East Quillimbury, Thence North and East, to 6<sup>th</sup> Con. then North, to the Line between 6 & 7 - Con. 5.

No. 44 To Commence on East Town Line at South Line of Lot No. 4, thence North, to the North Line of Lot 11.

No. 46 To Commence at the 5<sup>th</sup> Con. at the North line of Lot No. 11. Thence south to the Town Line

By Law No. 354

A By Law to Assess for County Purposes, for General Township Purposes, for Payment of School Teachers, On Account of Lake Simcoe Jurisdiction Railway Company, and, for the Payment of School Teachers and, other School expenses, in the several School sections.

Whereas the 36<sup>th</sup> Vic. Entitled an Act Respecting the Municipal Institutions of Ontario, gives Power to Municipal Councils to levy, and Collect Rates for the Above Named Purposes, ( Except Trustees Rates, )

And

Whereas, the Amend School Act, Makes it the Duty of Township Councils to Collect Trustees School Rates, when Application is Made by Trustees, as Aforesaid.

And

Whereas, it is necessary, that certain Amounts should be raised in the Township of North Gwillimbury.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury, and it is hereby enacted by the Authority Aforesaid, that there be levied and collected from all the Property rated on the Assessment Roll, for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Present year, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars, as follows, That is to say: For General Township Purposes, the sum of sixteen hundred dollars, For County Purposes the sum of eight hundred and eighty nine dollars and fifty three cents. For Payment of School Teachers, two hundred, and seventy nine dollars. For County Railway By Law, ten hundred and forty eight <sup>16</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars.
