By Law No. 359

A By Law to assess for County Purposes for General Township Purposes, for Payment of School Teachers, On Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company, County By Law, Also, L. S. J. N. N. Co. Township By Law, and for the Payment of School Teachers, and other School expenses in the several School Sections, as asked by Trustees.

Whereas the 36th Vic. Municipal Act, Section 340 gives Power to Municipal Councils to levy and Collect rates for the Above Named Purposes, Except Trustees Rates.

And

Whereas the Amended School Act, of 1879, Makes it the duty of Township Councils to Collect Trustees School Rates when Application is Made as Aforesaid

Whereas it is necessary that certain Amounts should be raised in the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Above Named Purposes,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury, And, it is hereby enacted by the Authority Aforesaid, that there be levied and collected from all the ~~rateable~~ Property rated on the Assessment Roll for the Present year the sum of five thousand and eighty two dollars and fifty nine cents That is to say: For County Purposes the sum of eight hundred and eighty three dollars and sixty three cents being a rate of one mill on the dollar

For

For General Township Purposes, the sum of eleven hundred and four dollars and sixty one cents being a rate of one, and one fourth mill in the dollar for Payment of School Teachers the sum of two hundred and twenty dollars, and sixty eight cents being a rate of one fourth of a Mill in the dollar On Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company, Township By Law the sum of one thousand seven hundred and sixty seven dollars and eighty six cents being a rate of two Mills on the dollar.

On account of the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company, County By Law the sum of eleven hundred and four dollars, and sixty one cents, being a rate of one, and one fourth Mill, on the dollar

And, for the several School sections, (to be levied on the Property in said Sections) (as near as may be) the following sums, (namely)

By Law No. 361

A By Law to fix the Place for holding the Nominations of Candidates for the Office of Reeve, Deputy-Reeve, and Councillors for the Year 1881, for fixing the Place in the several Polling Sub-divisions for holding the Election, and for Appointing Returning Officers.

Whereas, in Accordance with the Statutes of Ontario 36 Vic. Cap. 48, it becomes the duty of Township Councils to Pass By Laws, Appointing the Place for holding Nominations and Elections of Reeve, Deputy Reeve, and Councillors in the several Municipalities.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows:

1st That the Nominations for the Office of Reeve, Deputy-Reeve and Councillors for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1881, be held at Sheppard's Hall, Bellhaven.

2nd That the Municipal Elections for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1881, be held at the following named Places, that is to say:

For Polling Sub-division Number one, at Newberry's Hall, Jersey.

For Polling sub-division Number two, at Sheppard's Hall, Bellhaven.

For Polling sub-division Number three, at the School House, S. S. No. 7.

For Polling sub-division Number two, Thomas Sennett
For Polling sub-division, Number three, Joseph Davidson
