A By Law to Amend Consolidated  
By Law No 5 for the Township of North Guilford

The Municipal Council of the Corporation  
of the Township of North Guilford enact  
as follows. — That Consolidated By Law  
Number five for the Township of North  
Guilford passed on the twenty fourth  
day of April A.D. 1876. be, and it is hereby  
Amended by adding the following clause  
to section Number five of said By Law, viz.  
And if the Owner is not known to the Person  
taking up and retaining Possession of the  
Animal, such Person shall, within forty  
eight hours, deliver to the Clerk of the  
Municipality a Notice in writing of having  
taken up the Animal, and containing  
Description of the Color, Age, and Nature  
and Artificial Marks of the Animal,  
Near as may be

A By Law to Amend By Laws, No. 330 & 353. Relating to Road Divisions and to Reduce Statute Labor for 1881

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Quilleybury enacts as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> That Clause Number four of By Law Number 330 be, and it is hereby so amended as, to form a New Road Division including the side Road between Lots Numbers fifteen and sixteen in the second and third Concessions as far as Robert Cattle comes and that John Harrier be Overseer of said Road Division, said Road Division to be known as Road Division No. 49.

2<sup>nd</sup> That Road Division No. 6 (Clause No 6) in By Law No. 353. be so amended as to include the Property now owned by Walter Gillespie at Hoacher Point

3<sup>rd</sup> That Clause No. 30 in By Law No. 353. be amended by adding to the end of said Clause the words, "Thence west to the west line of the Premises of now owned by James Earl"

4 That there be a New Road Division formed to include Parts of Lots Nos. 15-16 & 17 in the 7<sup>th</sup> Concession east of the Black River

To Commence at the River between  
Lots No. 15 & 14 Thence Easterly to the  
Town Line and to include the 8<sup>th</sup>  
Concession from Lot No. 18 To the  
Road known as the Baldwin Road  
and to be Numbered Road-division  
No. 28.

5 That the Statute labour as  
assessed in the Assessment Roll  
for 1881 be reduced one fourth, and  
that the Clerk be instructed to  
make out the several Road Lists  
in accordance with this By Law.

6 That By Law No. 364 be amended  
by striking out the name of John  
Purdy and inserting the name of  
Elijah Prosser in lieu thereof.

By Law No. 366

By Law to Assess for County Purposes, for General Township Purposes, for Payment of School Teachers; On Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company, County By Law, Also, L. S. J. R. R. Co. Township By Law, And, for the Payment of School Teachers and other School expenses as asked by the School Trustees of the several School Sections.

Whereas the 36<sup>th</sup> Vic. Municipal Act Sec. 340 gives Power to Municipal Councils to Levy and Collect Rates for the above named Purposes, (except Trustees rate)

And

Whereas the Amended School Act of 1879 makes it the duty of Township Councils to Collect Trustees School rates when Application is made as aforesaid.

And

Whereas it is necessary that certain Amounts should be raised in the Township of North Guillem-bury for the above named Purposes, be it enacted by

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillem-bury, and it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid, that there be levied and Collected from all the Property rated on the Assessment Roll for

for the Present year the sum of four thousand, four hundred and eleven dollars, sixty cents & four Mills. That is to say: For County Purposes the sum of eight hundred and eighty two dollars, twenty two cents & five Mills being a rate of 1 Mill in the \$.

For General Township Purposes, the sum of five hundred and fifty one dollar, and thirty eight cents, being a rate of  $\frac{5}{8}$  of a Mill on the \$.

For Payment of School Teachers the sum of two hundred and twenty one dollar five cents & six Mills being a rate of  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a Mill on the \$.

On Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company County By Law, the sum of three hundred and twenty two dollars fifty cents and  $\frac{3}{10}$  being a rate of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  Mill on the \$.

On Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Township By Law, the sum of one thousand, seven hundred and sixty four dollars and forty four cents, being a rate of two Mills on the \$.

And, for the Several School Sections (to be levied on the Property in the said Sections) as near as may be, the following sums (Namely)

## By Law No. 367

A By Law to authorize and empower the Trustees of School Section No. 7 in the Township of North Guillemburg to borrow the sum of four hundred dollars for the purpose of building a New School House in said Section and to make Provisions for issuing Township Debentures for said Amount (if required)

Whereas the Trustees of School Section Number seven in the Township of North Guillemburg have taken the necessary steps, and have asked this Council to borrow the sum of four hundred dollars to assist them to build a New School House in said Section.

And—

Whereas it has become necessary that a New School House be built in said School Section and that the money be raised for that purpose.

And.

Whereas the Consolidated Statutes of Ontario Cap 204 Sec. 78. Subsections 9-10 & 11. Makes it the Duty of Township Councils to Pass By Laws, empowering School Trustees to borrow Money for Purchasing School Sites, building School Houses, Repairing &c. and authorize Council to issue Debentures Township Debentures, and to levy and collect upon the Property in said Section Above other rates a Sufficient Amount to Pay

Pay Principal and Interest of such Debentures, or such Amount so raised, Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North-  
 Gwillimbury enacts as follows;

1 That the Trustees of School Section Number seven in the Township of North Gwillimbury, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow, (on the credit of the said School Section) the sum of four hundred dollars for the purpose of building a new school House in said Section to be paid (with interest thereon) in two, yearly or Annual instalments of two hundred dollars each, on the fourteenth day of December in the year of Our Lord 1882 & 1883

2 That it shall be lawful and that this Council shall, if required by the Trustees aforesaid issue Township Debentures in accordance with the preceding clause of said By-Law and, in accordance with the Statute in that behalf for said amounts, and paying such interest as may be agreed upon by the said Parties

3 That the Council shall (if required) cause to be levied and collected in each of the two years (namely 1882 and 1883) for payment of the aforesaid Debentures or amounts borrowed Over and above  
 all

all other assessments, upon all  
the taxable Property in the said school  
section. Wherever there is a sufficient  
Amount to Pay such Debenture, or  
to Meet such liabilities

a By Law to fix the Place for holding the Nominations of Candidates for the Office of Reeve, Deputy Reeve and Councillors for the year 1882, for fixing the Place in the several Polling sub-divisions for holding the Election and for Appointing Returning Officers.

Whereas in Accordance with the Statutes of Ontario, 36<sup>th</sup> Vic Cap 48 it becomes the duty of Township Councils to Pass By Laws Appointing the Place for holding the Nominations and Elections of Reeve, Deputy Reeve and Councillors in the several Municipalities.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows:

1 That the Nominations for the Office of Reeve, Deputy Reeve, and Councillors for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the year 1882 to be held at Sheppard's Hall (Belhaven)

(If Required)

2 That the Municipal Elections for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the year 1882 be held at the following Named Places, that is to say: For Polling sub-division Number one at Newbrins Hall Jersey.

For Polling sub-division Number two at Sheppard's Hall, Belhaven.

For Polling sub-division Number three at the School House in School section No. 7. N.G.

3 That the following Named Persons be, and they are hereby Appointed deputy Returning Officers, to hold the Next Municipal Election as follows
