By Law No. 372

A. By Law to Assess for County Purposes, For General Township Purposes, For Payment of School Teachers; On Account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company, (County By Law) Also, Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company, (Township By Law) And for the Payment of School Teachers and other school expenses, as asked by the School Trustees of the several school sections.

Whereas the 36th Vic. Municipal Act, Sec. 340, gives Power to Municipal Councils, to levy, and collect rates for the above named Purposes, (except Trustees Rate,

And,

Whereas the Amended School Act of 1878 Makes it the duty of Township Councils to collect Trustees School rates when Application is made as aforesaid

And,

Whereas it is necessary that certain Amounts should be raised in the Township of North Gwillimbury for the aforesaid Purposes,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Incorporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury, And it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid, that there be levied and collected from all the Property rated on the Assessment Roll for the Present year the sum of four thousand

six hundred and forty nine dollars, six, one cent, six Mills & $\frac{3}{4}$, being a rate of $5\frac{3}{8}$ Mills. That is to say; for County Purposes, the sum of eight hundred and sixty five dollars four cents, five Mills, being a rate of one Mill on the dollar.

For General Township Purposes the sum of eight hundred and six five dollars, four and one half cents being a rate of one Mill on the dollar.

For Payment of School Teachers the sum of two hundred and sixteen dollars, twenty six cents, one Mill & Quarter, being a rate of one fourth of a Mill on the dollar.

For, And on Account of the Lake Superior Junction Railway Company, County By Law the sum of Nine hundred and seventy three dollars, seventeen cents $5\frac{5}{8}$ Mills, being a rate of one, and one eighth Mill on the dollar.

For, And on Account of the Lake Superior Company, (Township, By Law) the sum of one thousand seven hundred and thirty dollars & nine cents, being a rate of two Mills on the dollar.

And for the several School sections, to be levied on the Property in the said sections as near as may be, the following sums; Namely,
 For School section No. 1 the sum of \$290-00
 " " " " 2 " " " 370-00
 " " " " 3 " " " 375-00
 " " " " 4 " " " 375-00
 " " " " 5 " " " 250-00
 " " " " 6 " " " 300-00

Also, for School section No. 7 a Special rate, sufficient
to raise two hundred and twenty four dollars.

Also, in, and for Union School section, North
Gwillimbury & Georgia for Payment of Teacher
and other incidental expenses a rate of three
Mills in the dollar. And also a rate of one
and nine tenths of a Mill in the dollar to
Redeem Debt in said School section.

A. By Law to fix the Place for holding the Nomination of Candidates for the Office of Reeve, Deputy Reeve, and Councillors for the year 1883, for fixing the Place in the several Polling Sub-divisions, for holding the Election, and for Appointing Returning Officers

Whereas in Accordance with the Statute of Ontario, 36th Vic. Cap. 48, it becomes the duty of Township Councils to Pass By-Laws, Appointing the Place for holding the Nomination and Elections of Reeve Deputy Reeve, and Councillors in the several Municipalities

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury made as follows:
