4th

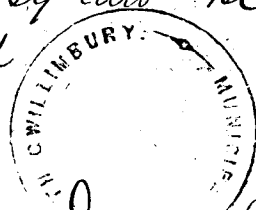
That David L. Willson be and is hereby appointed Assessor for the said Township of North Gwillimbury at a salary of sixty dollars per Annum.

Bylaw No 380

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for General Township purposes, for payment of school teachers on account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company (County Bylaw) on account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Township Bylaw) and for the the payment of school expenses as asked by the Trustees of the several sections

Whereas the 26th Vic Municipal Act 2340 gives power to Municipal Councils to levy & collect rates for all above purposes (except Trustee rates)

And

Whereas the Amended school act of 1879 makes it the duty of Township Councils, to collect Trustee rates when application is made as aforesaid

And

Whereas it is necessary that certain amounts should be raised in the Township of North Gwillimbury for purposes aforesaid

Therefore be it enacted by the ~~Authority~~ Municipal Council of the Township of North Gwillimbury, and it is hereby enacted by the Authority aforesaid, that there be levied and collected from all property rated on the Assessment Roll for the present year the sum of Four thousand Eight hundred and Seventy One dollars fifty nine & 4/10 cents being a rate of 5 1/2 Mills on the dollar, That is to say

For County purposes the sum of Eight hundred and eighty-five dollars and seventy four & 1/2 cts being a rate of One mill on the dollar

For General Township purposes the sum of Eight hundred and eighty-five dollars and seventy four & 1/2 cts being a rate of One mill on the dollar

For payment of school teachers the sum of Two hundred and twenty one dollars forty three & 1/10 cts being a rate of 1/4 mill on the dollar

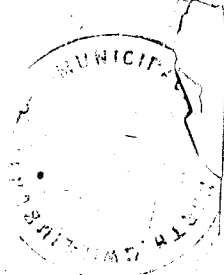

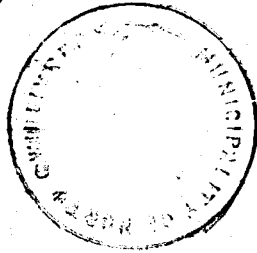

Bylaw No 376

A Bylaw to accept or assume the cemetery known as Richard Mann's burial ground and to make provisions for fencing and taking care of the same

Whereas the cemetery or burial ground known as Richard Mann's burial ground in this Municipality (although to all intents and purposes a public burial ground) has not been assumed by this Corporation or any other company or person and has therefore no person to take charge of it and keep up fences

And

Whereas by an Act passed by the Legislative Assembly of the province of Ontario 36th Vic c 148 Sec 379 Municipal Councils are authorized and empowered to accept, purchase or improve public burial grounds or cemeteries

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of North Willimbury enacts as follows, that the cemetery known as Richard Mann's burial ground be and is hereby accepted or assumed by this Council, and that a sufficient amount of money be expended to fence said cemetery being situated on lot Seventeen in the third concession of North Willimbury.

Bylaw No 382

A Bylaw to empower the Trustees of School Section No 6 of the Township of North Guillemburg to borrow on the credit of said Section the sum of (\$107) one hundred and seven dollars, and to make provision for issuing a debenture for said amount (if required)

Whereas it has become necessary to raise the sum of One hundred and seven dollars to meet payments of repairs done in said section

and

Whereas power is given councils to pass Bylaws empowering Trustees to borrow on the credit of said sections requiring money

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows,

That the Trustees of the above mentioned section are empowered to borrow on the credit of said section the sum of One Hundred and seven dollars, said amount to be levied and collected on the section above mentioned in the Year 1884 in addition to all other taxes which may be required
