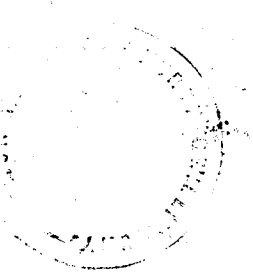

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for General Township purposes, the account of Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Ex Bylaw) also Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Op Bylaw) and for the several school sections, as required by Trustees of said sections

Whereas the (Res Sta. Act) gives power to Municipal Councils to levy and collect rates for all purposes except school rates, and whereas the Amended School Act makes it the duty of Township Councils to collect rates, when application is made as aforesaid

Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Cwilling and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the Assessment Roll for the Year 1885 the sum of five thousand and sixty nine and forty eight and three fourths cents, being a rate of $5\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the \$

That is to say, For County purposes the sum of nine hundred and twenty one dollars and seventy two and one half cents, being a rate of 1 mill on the \$

For General Township purposes the sum of nine hundred and twenty one dollars and seventy two and one half cents, being a rate of 1 mill on the \$

For payment of School Teachers the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars and forty three and one eighth cents being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mill on the \$

For industrial home the sum of Two hundred and thirty dollars, Forty three and one-eighth cents, being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mill on the \$

For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Co Bylaw) the sum of nine hundred and Twenty one dollars twenty two and one-half cents being a rate of 1 mill on the \$

For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Tp Bylaw) the sum of One thousand eight-hundred and forty three dollars and forty five cents being a rate of 2 mills on the \$

And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections as near as may be the following amounts viz

A Bylaw to appoint a Collector of Taxes for the Township of North Willimbury for the Year 1885

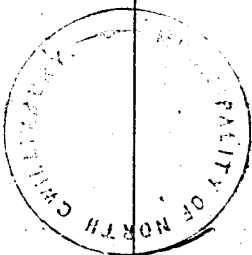
Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Willimbury.

Bylaw No 396

A Bylaw to fix the place for holding the Nomination of Candidates for the offices of Reeve, Deputy Reeve, and Councillors for the Year 1886, also the place for holding the Election in the several polling-divisions, and appointing Deputy Returning Officers

Whereas in accordance with (42 Vic Cap 18) it becomes the duty of Councils to pass bylaws appointing the place of holding the Nomination and Election in the several Municipalities;

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guillemburg enacts as follows

That the Nomination for the Offices of Reeve Deputy-Reeve and Councillors for the Township of North Guillemburg for the Year 1886 be held at Pollock's Hall Belhaven,

That the Election (if required) for the Township of North Guillemburg for the Year 1886 be held at the following named places

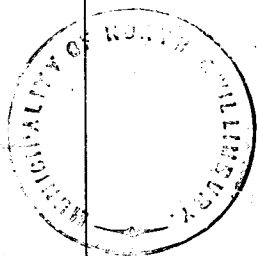
