Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury

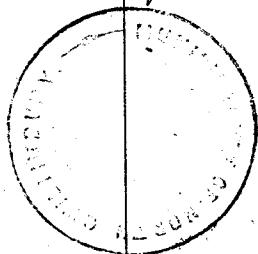

No 28

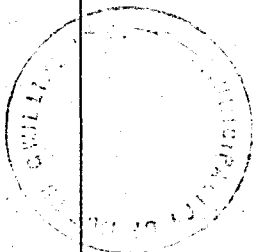

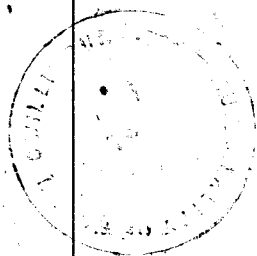

Bylaw No 401

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for Annual Township purposes, on account of the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Co Bylaw) also Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Tp Bylaw) and for the several school sections, as required by Trustees of said sections

Whereas the (Rev Sta Act) gives power to Municipal Councils to levy and collect rates, for all purposes except school rates; and whereas the Amended school act makes it the duty of Township Councils to collect rates, when application is made as aforesaid

Therefore be it enacted by the Corporation of the Township of North Etimburg, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same, that there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the Assessment Roll for the Year 1886, the sum of Four thousand nine hundred and Eighty one Dollars Ninety Five and one half cents; Being a rate of $5\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the \$, that is to say, for County purposes the sum of nine hundred and five dollars & eighty one cents being a rate of 1 mill on the \$, for Annual Township purposes the sum of nine hundred and five dollars & eighty one cents, being a rate of 1 mill on the \$

For payment of school teacher the sum of Two hundred and Twenty six dollars, forty five and $\frac{1}{4}$ cents being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mill on the \$, for Industrial Home, the sum of Two hundred and Twenty six dollars Forty five and $\frac{1}{4}$ cents, being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$

For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Co Bylaw) the sum of nine hundred and five dollars & eighty one cents being a rate of 1 mill on the \$,

For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Co Bylaw) the sum of One thousand eight hundred and eleven dollars and sixty two cents, being a rate of 3 mills on the \$

And for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections as near as may be the following amounts, viz

the Township aforesaid for the present Year

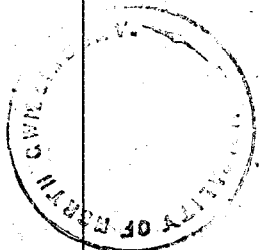

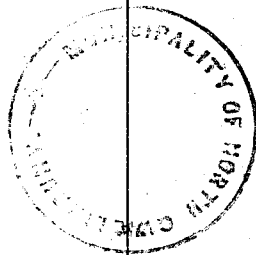
Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimburg enacts as follows

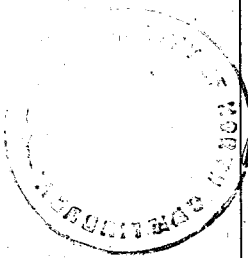
Bylaw No 404
