

the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1888


Be it enacted by the Council of

they may see fit



Whereas it is necessary to confirm said award


Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township

Bylaw No 421

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for General
Township purposes; On account of the Lake Simcoe Junction
Railway (See Bylaw) Also Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (See Bylaw)
and for the several school sections as required by the
Trustees of said sections.

Whereas the (Ree-Ita Act) gives power to municipal
councils to levy and collect rates for all purposes
above mentioned

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the
Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows

That there be levied and collected from all the Ratable property on the Assessment Roll for the Year 1888 the sum of 55-73⁶⁴ Five thousand five hundred and twenty three dollars and nineteen cents Being a rate of $6\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$; That is to say; For County purpose the sum of 1114⁶⁴ Eleven hundred and fourteen dollars and sixty-four cents Being a rate of $1\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$; For General Township purpose the sum of Thirteen hundred and thirty seven dollars and fifty-six cents, being a rate of $1\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the \$; For payment of School Teachers the sum of Two hundred and twenty two dollars and ninety-three cents being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$; For Industrial Home the sum of Two hundred and twenty two dollars and ninety-three cents, being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$; For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Co Bylaw) the sum of Eight hundred and ninety one dollars and seventy-one cents being a rate of 1 mill on the \$; For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Op Bylaw) the sum of Seventeen hundred and eighty-three dollars and forty-two cents, being a rate of 2 mills on the \$.

And for the several School Sections to be levied on the property in said sections, as near as may be the following amounts by

By law No 422

A By law to appoint three persons to act in connection with the ex officio offices of the Township of North Gwillimbury as a Local Board of Health

Whereas the Public Health Act of Oct makes it the duty of Township Council to appoint a Local Board of Health in each municipality

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows

That William Henry, Isaac Morris and Joe D. Davidson be and are hereby appointed members of the Local Board of Health for the Township of North Gwillimbury and that they receive the sum of \$⁰⁰ Two dollars each per day for their services for time actually spent as members of said Board

That Dr Bentley be and is hereby appointed Medical Health Officer for the said Township of North Gwillimbury and that he receive the sum of \$⁰⁰ per day and mileage for attending meetings of said Board

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enact as follows




