
A Bylaw to appoint certain Township Officers

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for General Township purpose : On account of the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Bylaw & for the several School Sections as required by Trustees of said sections

Whereas the (Rev. Sta Out) gives power to municipal councils to buy and collect rates for all purposes above-mentioned.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows,

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the Assessment Roll for 1889, the sum of \$537<sup>06</sup> Five thousand one hundred and thirty seven dollars and six cents being a rate of 8 mills on the \$. That is to say, for General Township purpose the sum of 1070<sup>22</sup> Ten hundred and seventy dollars and Twenty two cents being a rate of one  $\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$, for County purposes the sum of 1070<sup>22</sup> Ten hundred and seventy dollars and Twenty two cents being a rate of  $\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$, for payment of School Teachers the sum of Two hundred and fourteen dollars and four cents being a rate of  $\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$, for Industrial Home, the sum of Two hundred and fourteen dollars and four cents being a rate of  $\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$, for Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Co Bylaw - the sum of \$858<sup>18</sup> Eight hundred and fifty six dollars and eighteen cents being a rate of 1 mill on the \$. For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Township Bylaw the sum of \$712<sup>36</sup> Seven hundred and twelve dollars and thirty six cents, being a rate of 2 mills on the \$, and for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections, as near as may be the following amounts

A Bylaw to fix the place of Holding the Nomination of Candidates for the Office of Reeve, Deputy-Reeve and Councillors for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1890; Also the place for holding the Election in the several Polling-Divisions and appointing Deputy-Returning Officers

 - - - No 3 School-House No 7


