

A Bylaw to empower the trustees of School Section No 4 of the Township of North Gwillimbury to borrow on the credit of the said section the sum of \$300⁰⁰ Three hundred dollars, and to make provision for issuing a debenture for said amount - (if required)

Whereas it has become necessary to raise the sum of Three hundred dollars \$300⁰⁰ for payment of school site and other expenses,

and

Whereas power is given Council to pass bylaws empowering Trustees to borrow on the credit of said sections requiring money.

Therefore the Council of the corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enact as follows,

That the Trustees of the above mentioned Section are empowered to borrow on the credit of said section the sum of 300⁰⁰ Three Hundred Dollars, said amount to be levied and collected on the property in said section in the year 1890 in addition to all other taxes that may be required, and a debenture be issued for said amount

A Bylaw to fix the place of holding the nomination of Candidates for the Office of Reeve, Deputy-Reeve and Councillor for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1891: Also the place for holding the Election in the several polling-divisions, and appointing Deputy Returning Officers.

Whereas in accordance with (42 Vict, cap 18) it becomes the duty of Township Councils to pass Bylaws appointing the place of holding the Nomination and Election in the several Municipalities

Therefore, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows

That the Nomination for the Office of Reeve, Deputy-Reeve and Councillors for the Township of North Gwillimbury for the Year 1891 Be held at Culverwell's Hall Belgrave

That the Election required for the Year 1891 be held at the following place



A Bylaw to authorize and empower the Trustees of School section no 4 of the Township of North Givillibury to borrow on the credit of said section the sum of sixteen hundred dollars for payment of new school-house &c.

Whereas the Trustees of school section no 4 have applied to the Council to raise by Debenture the sum of sixteen hundred Dollars for payment of new school-house &c, in accordance with Sec 129 of the Public school act of Oct

Therefore

Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Givillibury, that the Trustees of the above-mentioned section be and are hereby empowered to borrow on the credit of said section the sum of sixteen hundred dollars, to be paid in four annual instalments of four hundred dollars each together with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum, the first payment to be made payable December the 14th One thousand eight-hundred and ninety-one. Said amounts to be levied and collected on the property in said sections in the years 1891, 1892, 1893 and 1894 in addition to all other taxes that may be required; and that Debenture be issued for the same.

a. By law to assess for County-purposes, for General Township purposes, on account of the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Bylaw and for the several School sections as required by trustee of said sections.

Whereas the (Re Stat Out) gives power to Municipal Councils to lay and collect rates for all purposes above mentioned:

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows,

That there be levied and collected from all the Rateable property on the Assessment Roll for 1890, the sum of 5339²⁵ Five thousand three hundred and thirty-nine dollars and twenty-five cents Being a rate of $6\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$\$. That is to say, for General Township purposes, the sum of One hundred and sixty-seven dollars and Eighty-five cents $167\frac{85}{100}$ Being a rate of $1\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$\$. For County purposes, the sum of One hundred and sixty-seven dollars and Eighty-five cents; Being a rate of $1\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$\$. For payment of school teachers, the sum of Two hundred and thirteen dollars and Fifty-seven cents; Being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$\$. For Industrial Home, the sum of Two hundred and thirteen dollars and Fifty-seven cents Being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$\$. For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Co Bylaw, the sum of One hundred and eighty-nine dollars and Eighty-five cents; Being a rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the \$\$. For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway (Op. Bylaw), the sum of Seventeen hundred and eight dollars and fifty-six cents; Being a rate of 2 mills on the \$; and for the several school sections to be levied on the property in said sections, as near as may be the following amounts—



A Bylaw to close and sell certain streets in
the Town-Plot of Keswick, Township of North Gwillimbury

Whereas the (Reo Sta Out) Chap 184 Sec 550 give power to Township Council to close and sell road allowances in certain cases; And whereas petition has been made to this Council that the following streets not being required for public travel be closed and sold.

Whereas due notice of the passing of this Bylaw as required by (Sec 546 of Chap 184) Reo Sta Out has been given

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury enacts as follows: That the following named streets in the Town Plot of Keswick be closed and sold J.S.M 1st namely. That portion of street North of Block 10 opposite Lots 4.5.6.7.8.9.10.11.12 or otherwise from Lot 3 East to Turner Street Lsm 1st also Gibbs Street north of Rain St to Wm Purdy's Line Lsm 2nd in Kennedy's in in in in in Lsm 3rd in Rain St - East of Gibbs St to J. B. Sprague's Line Lsm 4th and Road Allowance along the East side of the Town Plot of Keswick. And be it further enacted that the Reeve of the Township of North Gwillimbury be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and in behalf of this Municipality, and (under the corporal seal of the same) to dispose of and sell, and convey by deed in fee simple the above mentioned parts of streets
