Bylaw No 474

A Bylaw to assess for County Purposes, for General Township purposes, for Railway Bonus; and for the several School sections, as required by trustees of said sections.

Whereas, power is given Municipal Councils, to levy and collect rates for all purposes above mentioned; Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Wellington enacts as follows.

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property on the Assessment Roll for 1894, the sum of \$3005 <sup>43</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Five thousand and five dollars and forty three cents being a rate of  $6\frac{3}{4}$  mills on the \$, that is to say.

For General Township purposes, the sum of \$1668 <sup>48</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Sixteen hundred and sixty-eight dollars and forty eight cents being a rate of  $2\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$.

For County Purposes, the sum of \$1112 <sup>32</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Eleven hundred and twelve dollars and thirty two cents, being a rate of  $\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$.

For County School purposes, the sum of \$185 <sup>38</sup>/<sub>100</sub> One hundred and eighty-five dollars and thirty eight cents, being a rate of  $\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$.

For Industrial Home, the sum of \$370 <sup>77</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Three hundred and seventy dollars and seventy seven cents being a rate of  $\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$.

For Lake Simcoe Junction Railway, the sum of \$1668 <sup>48</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Sixteen hundred and sixty-eight dollars and forty eight cents, being a rate of  $2\frac{1}{4}$  mills on the \$.

And for the several School sections, to be levied on the property in said sections, as near as may be the following amounts -
