By law No 480

A Bylaw to assess for County purposes, for General Township purposes, for Railway Bonus; and for the several school sections, as required by trustees of said sections.

Whereas power is given Municipal Councils to levy and collect rates for all purposes above-mentioned therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Gwillimbury, enacts as follows;

That there be levied and collected, from all the Rateable property on the Assessment Roll, for 1895;

J. M. the sum of \$4995⁶⁷/₁₀₀, four thousand nine hundred & ninety five dollars, and sixty seven cents, being a rate of 6³/₄ mills on the \$. That is to say, for General Township

J. M. purposes, the sum of fourteen hundred and eighty dollars, and twenty cents \$1480²⁰/₁₀₀, being a rate of two mills on

J. M. the \$. For County purposes, the sum of two hundred and ninety-five dollars and eighteen cents \$1295¹⁸/₁₀₀,

J. M. being a rate of 1³/₄ mills on the \$. For County School purposes, the sum of one hundred and eighty-five dollars and two cents, being a rate of 1/4 mills

J. M. on the \$. For Industrial Home, the sum of three hundred and seventy dollars and five cents, being a rate of 1/2 mills on the \$. For Railway Bonus, the sum of

J. M. sixteen hundred and sixty-five dollars and twenty-two cents being a rate of 8¹/₄ mills on the \$. And for the several school sections to be levied

on the property in said sections, as near as may be the following amounts. School Section No 1 - \$230

A Bylaw to fix the place of holding the nomination of candidates for the Office of Reeve, Deputy Reeve and three Councillors, for the Township of North Gwillimbury, for the Year 1896, also the place of holding the election in the several polling-divisions, and appointing Deputy Returning Officers.
