Bylaw no 497

To define and mark Boundary lines on marsh swamp or water-covered lands.

Whereas under the authority of S.S. 7. Sec 545 of The consolidated Municipal Act; formerly S.S. 13 Sec 521, Cap 42.55 Vic. The Council of every Township have power to pass Bylaws permitting owners of Marsh, swamp or lands covered with water; to mark the boundary lines thereof by certain posts instead of fences.

And whereas it is desirable to pass such a Bylaw.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilford, in the County of York as follows.

- 1 That where any Boundary line, or part of Boundary line, within this Municipality passes through any swamp, marsh or lands covered with water, the same shall so far as respects that part of such boundary line which so passes through marsh, swamp or land covered with water; be deemed to be wholly enclosed within the meaning of Section 17 of "The Act respecting Petty Trespasser" if posts are put up and maintained along such part of such line, at distances, which will permit of each being clearly visible from the adjoining post.
- 2 This Bylaw shall come into force immediately after the passing thereof

A Bylaw to assess for county purposes, for General Township purposes, and for the several school sections, as required by the Trustees of said sections.

Whereas power is given municipal councils, to levy and collect rates, for all purposes above-mentioned; therefore the council of the Corporation of the Township of North Guilfleur, enacts as follows.

That there be levied and collected from all the rateable property, on the Assessment Roll for 1898, the sum of \$3363²⁰ (Three thousand three hundred and sixty-three Dollars and Thirty cents, being a rate of 4 1/2 mills on the \$.

That is to say, For General Township purposes the sum of \$747⁴⁰ seven hundred and forty seven dollars, and forty cents, being a rate of 1 mill on the \$. For General School purpose, the sum of \$1121⁴⁰ One thousand, one hundred and twenty-one dollars, and ten cents, being a rate of 1 1/2 mills on the \$. For county purposes, the sum of \$1121⁴⁰ One thousand, one hundred and twenty one dollars and ten cents, being a rate of 1 1/2 mills on the \$. For Industrial Home, the sum of \$373⁷⁰ Three hundred and seventy three dollars and seventy cents, being a rate of 1/2 mills on the \$.

And for the several school sections, to be levied on the property in said sections, as near as may be the following amounts.
